Seed Corn germinated for vigor and freedom from disease — every ear germinated, hand shelled and graded, \$10.00 per bushel.

If you are not ready to have your seed shipped now, send us \$1.00 a bushel deposit and we will hold it until you tell us to ship. This insures delivery when you want it. The balance is due when you order it shipped. In previous years we have held corn ordered, without a deposit. In some cases the order was not ordered shipped.

K. UTILITY TYPE SEED CORN

GERMINATED FOR VIGOR AND FREEDOM FROM DISEASE

Every ear tested on our germinators has been picked from the multiplying plots on the Funk Farms which for six years have been planted with only tested disease-free seed of the highest yielding strains. The ears selected are those showing apparent freedom from diseases.

Several kernels are taken from the whole ears, placed on the germinating tables and left for seven days. At this time the majority of the root rot diseases can be detected and the weak and diseased ears discarded.

When all kernels are free from disease and show strong root development their ears are retained. The desirable tested ears are shelled separately by hand and the kernels inspected.

PRICE. This year we are selling the tested seed corn at \$10.00 per bushel ($\frac{1}{2}$ bu. \$6.00) shelled and graded. We are not offering this seed in the ear because we can eliminate some undesirable ears by hand shelling.

An ear of corn may show freedom from disease over the germinator, but may be discarded by us after it is shelled on account of the quality or composition of the kernel.

We insist on your giving us an opportunity to make this "last ditch" test as it is just as much to our advantage as it is yours to have this corn yield the largest number of bushels of sound seed next fall. This is your insurance.
