PREFACE.

Having been a collector of "Confederate Currency" for many years, naturally, the errors that have crept into publications on the subject have been discovered, and many varieties have been found not heretofore described. I have for several years hoped that some one more competent than myself, would undertake the work of compiling a descriptive and chronological catalogue, correcting errors in former publications, add new varieties discovered, and at the same time make the work so plain and comprehensive that the various notes could be easily located. After discussing the subject with a number of advanced collectors, I was persuaded to undertake the task, agreeing with them, that a correct list, properly arranged and fully described, would supply a want long felt in this very interesting and rapidly increasing branch of collecting. These gentlemen very kindly placed their splendid collections at my disposal, so that by the aid of these, added to my own private collection, and large stock on hand, I am able to present to collectors of "Confederate Currency" a catalogue that I believe is absolutely correct, in serial letters, series, numbers, engravers, &c. Many more varieties might be added, if minute variations in scroll work, &c., would be considered. I have only given place to distinct variations in letters, numbers, series, decided differences in ornamental work, engravers, and position of engravers' names.

The one in my collection, and all others that have come under my observation are undoubtedly frauds, will not call them counterfeits, as I have no knowledge of their ever having been a genuine note of this type issued. A conflict of opinion exists among collectors on this subject, and the mystery surrounding it, is one of the many fascinations connected with collecting. A very intelligent collector of Confederate notes, said to me not long since, I know positively that genuine notes of this type were issed. One thing is very certain, all collectors want one of these notes. It is a conceded fact among coin collectors that the so called, "Jefferson head cent," is not a U. S. Mint issue, yet they are held in high esteem, and always sell very high.
