Part 1. Reference Plan STRING. Agreement has been reached between DA and DAF concerning trf of service support functions in Philippine Islands in order to implement Plan STRING. Further request you expedite as a matter of priority.

64 A. The intent of the adjustments directed herein is to provide a basis for implementation of plans involving certain actions to be accomplished in the Far East and as specifically identified in the reference cited under para 1 B (4) above.

B. The responsibility for the performance of service support functions above the base level in the Philippine Islands will be transferred from the DA to the DAF effective 1 May 49. The responsibility for service support functions at the base level having been previously transferred in accordance with the provisions of JAAFAR 1-11-50 dtd 5 Nov 48 but limited to only certain functions in the Philippine Islands, there will be transferred, in addition to those base level service support functions previously transferred, the following:

4. Personnel to accompany spaces and authorizations-

A. Effective 1 May 49 pers of the DA currently on duty in the service support functions for which the DAF is herein assuming the responsibility will be assigned to DAF for the remainder of FY 49 and for the FY 50 in the same manner as SCARWAF individuals are assigned unless sooner replaced by DAF pers. Da will not furnish loss replacements except for such critical specialists as may be subsequently agreed to between the respective services. Prior to the termination of FY 50 the pers situation as it pertains to the responsibilities being transferred will be reviewed to determine whether or not the DAF is capable within its personnel resources of providing all trained replacements required. In the event it is determined that the DAF is unable to provide trained replacements by the termination of FY 50 in view of pers shortages in critical skills, the DA will continue to provide SCARWAF pers during the FY 51 unless sooner replaced by DAF pers.

5. Theater responsibility-

A. In effecting the adjustments authorized herein the theater commander will take the necessary actions where appropriate.

B-4 6. Funds-

A. The DA will continue to directly fund these responsibilities during the remainder of FY 49 and for FY 50 will make funds available to the DAF in such manner and amounts as agreed upon by the comptrollers of those departments in consonance with changes directed herein. The DAF will be responsible for budgeting for these transferred activities in FY 51 and subsequent FY.

B-4 7. Supplies and equipment-

A. The transfer of supplies and equipment will be in accordance with the provisions of Joint Army Memo 700-10-19, AF Ltr 67-12, dtd 29 Sep 48, subj: "Allocation of stocks between Army and AF in oversea theaters." Transfers other than provided for in this joint publication shall be as directed by the theater commander.

B-4 8. Real property and facilities-

A. Effective 1 May 49, all rights, interests, and responsibilities as to real property and facilities of the DA

10. Administrative instructions-

A. Current DA and DAF publications applicable to the transfers directed herein, with the exception of any provisions contained therein which conflict with these and other joint adjustment regulations cited, will continue in force and apply to the USAF until such time as they are, or may be replaced by appropriate DA and/or DAF publications.

Gen Whitehead requested me to make special investigation on efficacy of implementing Plan STRING which proposes that Army garrisons of aprx 1,800 mil pers providing logistical support to Clark Fld withdraw fr Philippines and AF become self supporting by transfer of aprx 950 troop spaces fr Army to AF. Gen Crabb and Gen Anderson, PHILCOM, the local commanders, are in complete agreement that Army should withdraw and AF assume its own support responsibilities. Gen Whitehead and Gen MacArthur also agree. Chief of Staff, CINCFE, advises me DA has approved plan and he will press Gen Wedemeyer for official decision. Unofficial info indicated DAF is not favorably inclined toward this plan for reasons unknown to me. There is no controversy within the theatre. Plan "STRING" appears to me not only feasible but a definite step in unification with a considerable saving in overall economy of mil establishment. This plan was developed in 1948 but decision has been delayed at high level fr month to month and not yet reached. This plan has far reaching implications in that if it is not approved the Army will take over Fort Stotsenberg and Baguio leaving the AF only a runway and a few hangers thereby placing the combatant air units in the position of tenants on an Army supporting base. PHILCOM must evacuate Manila Area by 30 Jun and movements are now in progress. Re AX 1928 A-3 Plans dtd 26 Feb 49 and Hq USAF reply whereto indicates joint adjustment regulation in process of interdepartmental coordination. Strongly recommend HQ USAF

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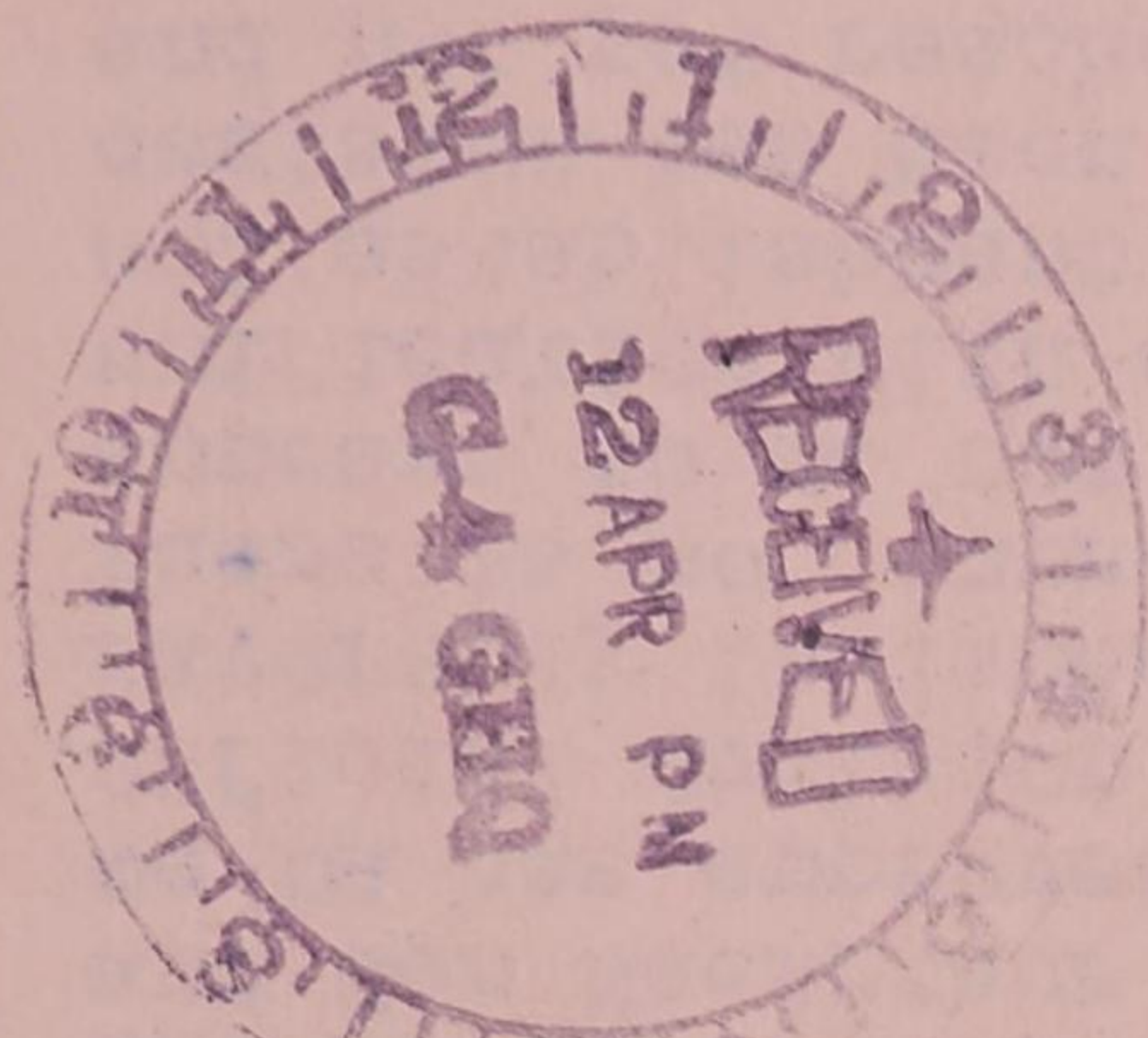

give favorable consideration to this plan, expedite co-ordination and issuance of joint adjustment regulation. This is a major theatre problem and further recommend that Gen Street be prepared to explain AF position to Gen MacArthur upon arrival in Tokyo. Gen Whitehead now in Washington can further elaborate on implications and urgent necessity for prompt action in this case. Will return Tokyo by 16 Apr via Guam, Okinawa and Nagoya.

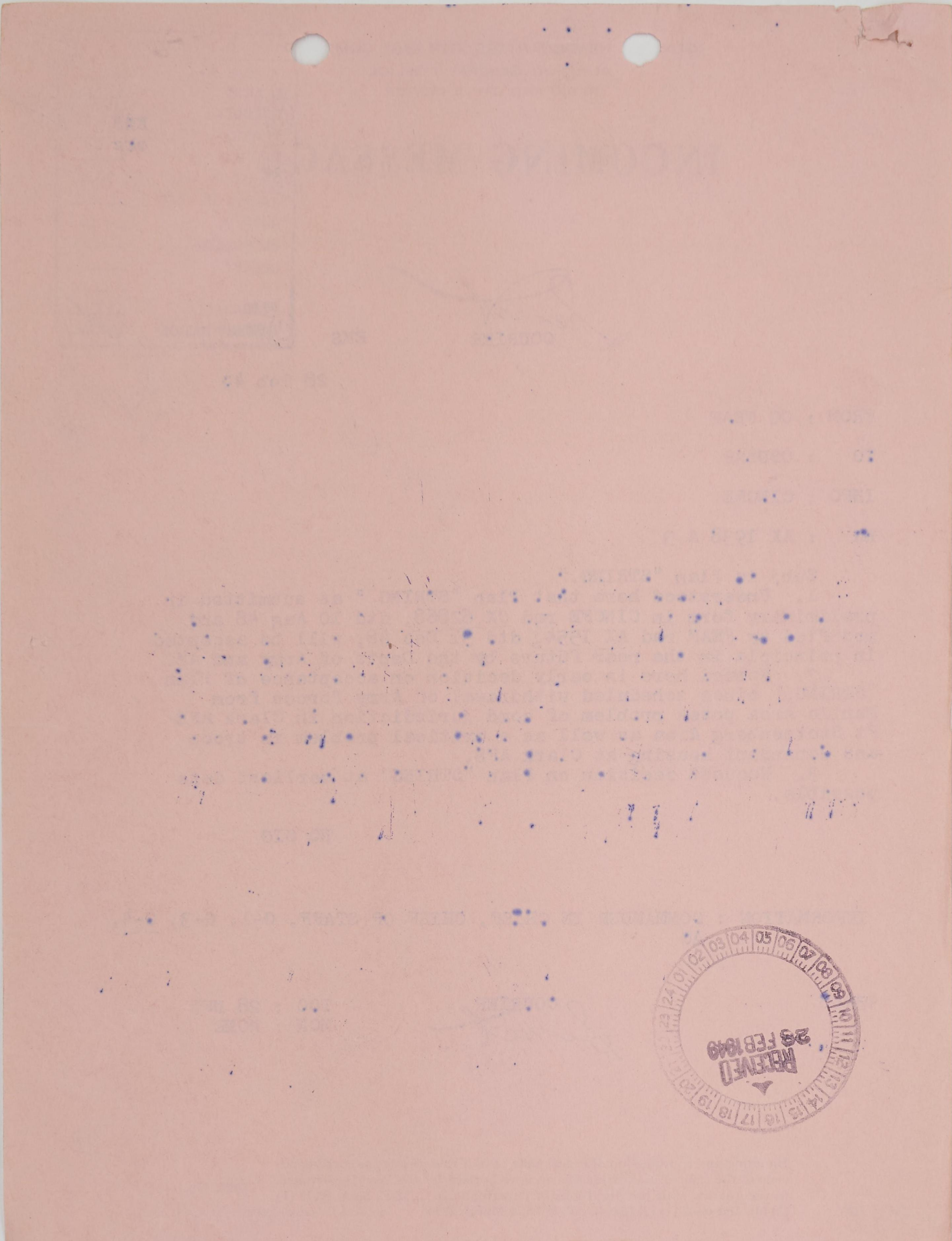

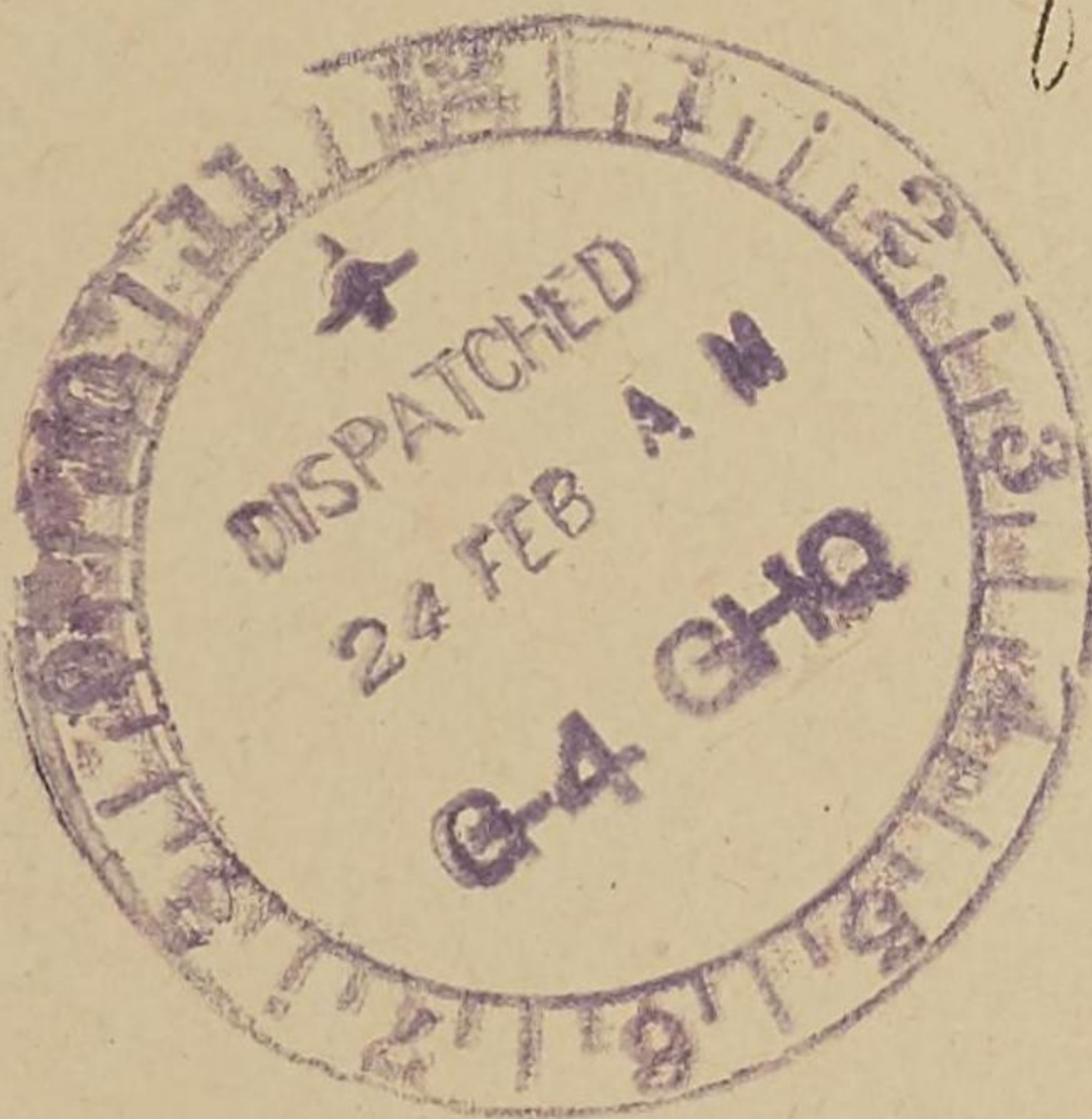

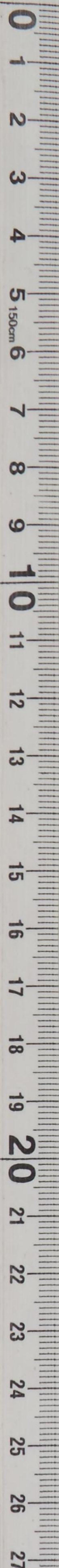

 1. It is anticipated that Plan STRING as submitted in preliminary form on 10 August 1948 in rad CX 62868 will be accepted in principle in the near future by the Depts of Army and Air Force. Prompt action within GHQ to initiate implementation is imperative in order that full utilization may be made of PHILCOM's steadily diminishing resources in personnel and funds.
 2. G-3 plans to call a conference as soon as word is received in GHQ of the approval of STRING. The interdepartmental agreement will undoubtedly modify some of the provisions of the 10 August 1948 plan. Other provisions will require modification in the light of current conditions.
 3. With an objective of determining the immediate steps which should be taken to initiate implementation, G-3 has prepared a proposed agenda, (Incl 1). It is requested that G-1 and G-4 in conjunction with appropriate special staff sections give this agenda such preliminary study and review as will enable the conferees, meeting with only a few hours advance notice, to reach the essential conclusions indicated.
 4. For your information there are attached (Incl 2) the informal comments of G-3 and G-4, PHILCOM which were prepared during their recent visit to GHQ.

Recommendations of letter GHQ, FEC file AG 200.3 (13 Jun 48) GD-GC, subject: Troop Basis and Civilian Personnel Authorizations, dated 13 Jun 48, (as amended by concurrence in loan of 26 spaces, part of 218 described in rad Z 25265) are still applicable. Thus, plan and assumptions contemplate ^{091.712} AF reorganization to Base Wing without assistance from FEC troop basis except for the loan of 26 spaces.

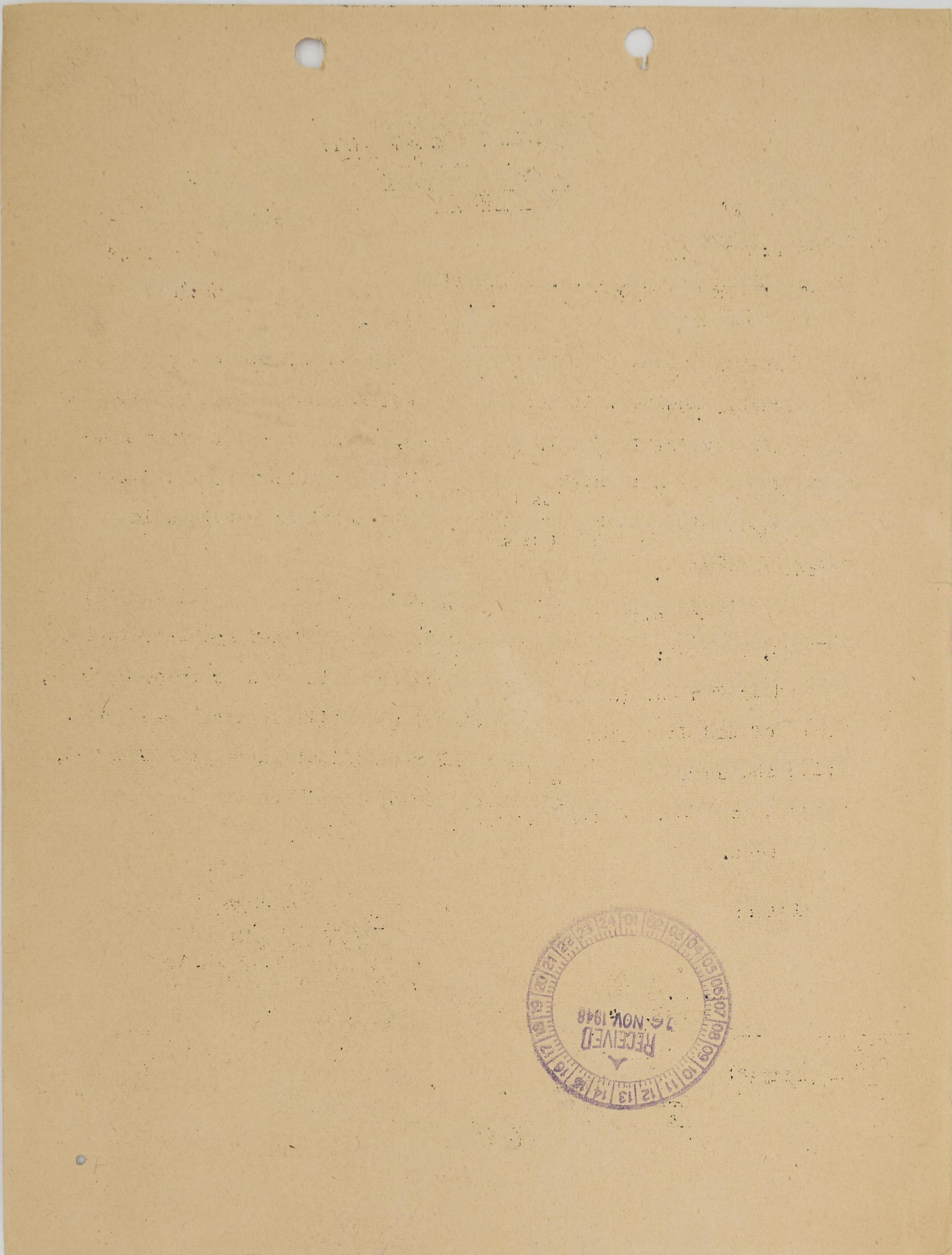
