## THE FOUNDERS.

"THEIR WORKS DO FOLLOW THEM."



THE memory of the men who established the first Medical School in this country will ever be cherished by the Profession. They are:—JOHN STEPHENSON, ANDREW FERDINAND HOLMES, WILLIAM ROBERTSON, and WILLIAM CALDWELL.

In October, 1822, these gentlemen, constituting the Medical Board of the recently organized General Hospital, adopted resolutions in favour of the establishment of a Medical School. On the 4th of February, 1823, the following advertisement was issued:—

### "Montreal Medical Institution.

“THE medical officers of the Montreal General Hospital having seen the great difficulties which the student of medicine in Canada has to encounter before he can acquire a competent knowledge of his profession; knowing the inconvenience resulting to many from the necessity at present existing of spending several years in a foreign country to complete a regular medical education; considering that the recent establishment of the Montreal General Hospital affords the student a facility of acquiring a practical knowledge of physic never before enjoyed in this Province, and that this advantage will be greatly



enhanced by delivering courses of lectures on the different branches of the profession, held a meeting to consider the practicability of founding a Medical School in this city.

“The circumstances which rendered the success of such an institution probable, and the measures intended to be adopted for carrying the same into effect, having been submitted to His Excellency, the Governor-in-Chief, he was pleased to signify his entire approbation of the plan.

“It is therefore resolved to deliver lectures on the following branches of the profession, to commence on the second week of November next ensuing :—

Anatomy and Physiology . . . . . J. STEPHENSON, M.D.  
 Chemistry and Pharmacy . . . . . A. F. HOLMES, M.D.  
 Practice of Physic . . . . . W. CALDWELL, M.D.  
 Midwifery and Diseases of Women  
 and Children . . . . . W. ROBERTSON, Esq.  
 Materia Medica . . . . . H. P. LOEDEL, Esq.  
 Surgery . . . . . J. STEPHENSON, M.D.

#### JOHN STEPHENSON

Was born in Montreal in 1797. Educated in “le College de Montreal,” he then went to Edinburgh with his friend A. F. Holmes, and after graduating in Arts, proceeded to the degree in Medicine in 1820; his Thesis being “De Velosynthesis.” Returning to Montreal, he was elected on the staff of the General Hospital, and was energetic in the establishment of the Medical Institution, in which he lectured on Surgery, Anatomy, and Physiology. He was the first Secretary of McGill College. He died in 1842, aged 45.

#### ANDREW FERDINAND HOLMES

Was born in Cadiz in 1797, studied Medicine with Dr. Daniel Arnoldi, and obtained the Provincial License in 1816. Proceeding to

Edinburgh he graduated in 1819. Thesis "De Tetanu." He was early elected a member of the Hospital Staff, and lectured on Chemistry, Pharmacy, and Botany, in the Medical Institution. In 1843, he succeeded Dr. Robertson as the lecturer on Medicine. In 1853 he was made the first Dean of the Medical Faculty. He died in 1860, aged 63.

#### WILLIAM ROBERTSON

Was born in Perthshire in 1784. Studied Medicine in Edinburgh. Appointed Assistant Surgeon to the 49th Regiment, he served through the war of 1812, being present at the storming of Niagara; at the declaration of peace, he retired on half-pay and settled in Montreal. He was a member of the first Medical Board of the Hospital; lectured on Midwifery and Diseases of Women in the Medical Institution, and on Medicine, after Dr. Caldwell's death, in the Medical Faculty. He died in 1844.

#### WILLIAM CALDWELL

Was born in Ayrshire in 1785. Studied Medicine in Edinburgh. He was Surgeon to the 13th Regiment of Dragoons; a member of the first staff of the General Hospital; lectured on Medicine in the Medical Institution and in the Medical Faculty. He died of Typhus in 1833.

---

**T**HE first session of which there is any record is that of 1824-25, at which twenty-five students attended. The Medical Institution continued for five sessions, and in 1829 became the Medical Faculty of McGill College, thereby preserving for educational purposes the bequest of the Hon. JAMES MCGILL.

In 1823 an attempt was made to organize McGill College and five Professors were appointed, one, Dr. Fargues, to the chair of Medicine. They never entered upon their duties.

Up to 1853 there was only one Professorship in the Medical Faculty. At this date the various Lecturers were made Professors.

**A**MONG those connected with the Medical Institution, must be mentioned H. P. Lœdel, Assistant Surgeon, Royal Artillery, who in the first advertisement has the lectureship on Materia Medica. So far as is known, he did not lecture. He died of Typhus in 1825.

**T**HE lectures were suspended during the political troubles of the rebellion ; there were no sessions in 36-37, 37-38 and 38-39. It is owing to this gap that the present is only the 50th session, though the Faculty was organized in 1829. In reality, this is the 55th session of the School, which is the direct continuation of the Medical Institution, and the 58th year since its foundation in 1824.

**T**HE lectures of the Medical Institution were given at No. 20 St. James Street ; the School afterwards moved to St. George Street ; from 1845 to 1852 the lectures were delivered in the College building, Sherbrooke Street ; from 1852 to 1872 in the Faculty building, Cotté Street ; and in 1872, the present building was erected by the Governors in the University Grounds.
