S. Embassy employees, one being Mrs. MARJORIE A. LENNOX, an employee of the Commercial Section, and , who was listedas a Third Secretary at the U. S. Embassy Also arrested were four undercover operatives of CIA who are North Americans. The Government was also able to confiscate much technical equipment which was used in this technical surveillance. Photographs of the technical equipment were published in the newspaper and consisted of numerous tape recorders, and other monitoring equipment. In connection with this operation, various other CIA operatives were compromised. Included among these were the following who were assigned as officers at and another female employee of the U. S. Embassy who was secretary to the Administrative Officer and Security Advisor, that actually she was the one who was working in an undercover capacity for CIA and not MARJORIE A.
