1. Reference is made to memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 386.7 (1 Mar 48)GPG/CD, SCAPIN 1868, 1 March 1948, subject, "Disposition of Properties Belonging to Dissolved Organizations," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, as amended by memorandum for the Japanese Government, file AG 386.7 (1 Mar 48) GPG/PLD, SCAPIN 1868/1, 30 December 1948, same subject.
2. Inclosed is a list of properties located throughout Japan belonging to Dissolved Organizations and now in use by the Occupation Forces.
3. Pursuant to the provisions of reference memorandum the Japanese Government is charged with the sale of Dissolved Organizations' properties. In order to sell such properties that are in use by the Occupation Forces it will be necessary for representatives of the Japanese Government to enter such properties for the purpose of making arrangements for appraisal, sale, etc. and also it will be necessary that prospective purchasers be allowed an opportunity to inspect the properties prior to sale.
4. To expedite said sales it is requested that the present occupants be advised of the above and requested to grant Japanese Government officials and prospective purchasers permission to enter said properties for the purposes outlined above, providing such permission will not greatly inconvenience the present occupants or violate security regulations.
5. To minimize any inconvenience that might be caused, the Attorney-General's Office, Japanese Government will be advised to keep inspections to an absolute minimum and that prior to inspection mutually agreeable arrangements will be made with the present users.

7. It is requested that when approval is granted, such approval be forwarded to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian.

2. The Civil Property Division, Reparations Board is directed to impound and place in protective custody the Singer sewing machines and the drilling machine listed in the inclosure which were reported as looted in compliance with reference 1b above. The sewing machines will be impounded in the Hakozaki Looted Property Warehouse, and the drilling machine in the Osaka Arsenal Looted Property Warehouse.

3. Upon completion of the impounding, the Civil Property Division Reparations Board will submit necessary L-2 Inventory Forms to the Civil Property Custodian, Comptroller Division, Accounts Branch, and obtain CPC numbers which will be placed on each machine. The sewing machines will be arranged in the warehouse according to the country from which looted, and each machine will have a tag affixed indicating the prefix, serial number, area from which looted, name and address of former Japanese possessor and the CPC number.

4. The Civil Property Division, Reparations Board is also directed to investigate and report on the present location, condition and/or disposition made of approximately 50 machines of various types which were reportedly bought in Shanghai during 1941 and 1942 by the Kanegafuchi Spinning Company and shipped to Japan.

5. A report that the actions directed in paragraphs 2 and 3 above have been completed and the report required in paragraph 4, above will be submitted to the Civil Property Custodian within thirty (30) days from date of memorandum.
