Cabinet Order No. 120

Cabinet Order concerning the Special Instance for the Liquidation of the Old Account of Closed Institutions in accordance with the provisions of Article 58 of the Financial Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law.

Article 1. With regard to the liquidation of the old account as well as the disposition of claims and liabilities of Closed Institutions prescribed by Article 1 of the Closed Institutions Ordinance (Imperial Ordinance No. 74 of 1947), which are the financial institutions prescribed by Article 27 of the Law regarding the Emergency Measures for the Accounts of Financial Institutions (Law No. 6 of 1946) (excluding the Yokohama Specie Bank, Ltd., hereinafter as to "Closed Financial Institutions"), they shall not be subject to as provided for in the Financial Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law (Law No. 39 of 1946) but be subject to as provided for in this Cabinet Order.

Article. 2. With regard to the old account of Closed Financial Institutions, as well as claims and liabilities thereof, the Special liquidation as prescribed by the provisions of Article 8 of the Closed Institutions Ordinance shall be executed.

Article 3. The segregation of the new and old accounts of Closed Financial Institutions shall become extinct on the day designated by the Minister of Finance.

Supplementary Provisions:

Article 4. This Cabinet Order shall apply as from the day on which the Financial Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law was enforced; provided that the provisions of Article 5 shall apply as from June 30, 1947.

Article 5. A part of the Cabinet Order concerning the Exceptional measures of the Readjustment of Assets and Liabilities of the Old Account of the Yokohama Specie Bank, Ltd. (Cabinet Order No. 115 of 1947) shall be amended as follows:

Article 10-(2). The provisions of Article 3 of the Cabinet Order concerning the Special Instance for the Liquidation of the Old Account of Closed Institutions in accordance with the provisions of Article 58 of the Financial Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law (Cabinet Order No. 120 of 1948), shall apply mutatis mutandis to the Yokohama Specie Bank, Ltd.

Article 10-(3). With regard to the Yokohama Specie Bank, Ltd., the provisions of Paragraph 2 of Article37 of the Financial Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law shall not apply. Minister of Finance

Matters concerning the special instances in Article 2 of the Enforcement Regulations of the Local Apportionment Tax Law relating to the Apportionment of the Local Apportionment Tax in the fiscal year 1948-1949 shall be provided as follows:

The amount of the Local Apportionment Tax to be delivered in or for the duration of May 1948, notwithstanding the provisions of Article 2 of the Local Apportionment Tax Law shall be classified as follows:

(1) The Do, Fu or Ken Apportionment Tax: Within one-fifth of the amount corresponding to the total amount of the first to third categories inclusive of Apportioned Amount in the apportioned amount of the Apportionment Tax in the fiscal year 1948-1949.

(2) The City, Town and Village Apportionment Tax: Within one-forth of the amount corresponding to the total amount of the first to third categories inclusive of Apportioned Amount in the apportioned amount of the Apportionment Tax in the fiscal year 1948-1949; provided that the Izu Seven Islands: Within 40% of the apportioned amount of the Apportionment Tax in the fiscal year 1947-1948.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from May 1, 1948.

MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

Ministry of Education Ordinance No. 5

May 20, 1948

The Regulations for Upper Secondary School Correspondence Education shall be prescribed as follows:

Minister of Education MORITO Tatsuo

Regulations for Upper Secondary School Correspondence Education

Article 1. According to the provisions of Article 45 of the School Education Law, the upper secondary school correspondence education shall be conducted in accordance with these regulations.

Article 2. An upper secondary school may conduct correspondence education for students within the prefecture.

Students from other prefecture can be admitted to the correspondence education, if, in the judgement of the competent prefectural educational authorities, admission of such student from outside the prefecture is warranted.

Article 3. When an upper secondary school desires to conduct correspondence education, it must obtain the approval of the competent authorities by submitting a written application with the following items in it.

- 1. The area where correspondence education is to be conducted;
- 2. Regulations for correspondence education;
- 3. Expenses and measures for maintenance;
- 4. Opening date.

For any change in the Items 1, 2 and 3, the approval of the competent authorities must be obtained.

Article 4. The regulations for correspondence education mentioned in Article 3, Item 2, shall contain at least the following items:

1. Matters concerning courses to be offered;

2. Matters concerning instruction;

3. Matters concerning methods of examinations and the recognition of completion of courses;

Matters concerning the full complement of correspondence students and organization of teaching staff;

5. Matters concerning entrance, withdrawal, transfer and change of courses;

6. Matters concerning the entrance fee and cost of each course.

Article 5. In case an upper secondary school conducts correspondence education, the matters concerning the courses to be offered, instruction, methods of examinations and the recognition of completion of courses, entrance, withdrawal, transfer and change of courses as mentioned above, shall be decided according to the standard given in "Course of Study for Correspondence Instruc-

Article 6. The upper secondary school which conducts correspondence education must have a certain number of full-time teachers for correspondence education.

The basic rate of the number of the fulltime teachers in charge of correspondence education shall be one up to 100 students, two up to 200 students, and one shall be added for every additional increase of 200 students up to 1000 students, and one or more shall be added for every additional increase of 300 students in case of more than 1000 students.

Article 7. If any school desires to discontinue correspondence education, the establisher must obtain the approval of the competent authorities by submitting an application reporting the reason of discontinuance and measures for the disposal of the correspondence students enrolled at the time of discontinuance.

Article 8. The students who attend a part-time upper secondary school (including night courses) may take any correspondence courses they desire, with the permission of the director of the school they belong to.

Article 9. Correspondence students may enter a parttime upper secondary school (including night courses) with the permission of the director of the school concerned.

Article 10. The director of an upper secondary school which conducts correspondence education may give permission to enroll in correspondence courses as special students the persons of sufficient maturity and experience who lack certain educational prerequisites for correspondence courses, if he deems these persons capable of taking the courses successfully.

Article 11. Some credit can be allowed for correspondence work in the upper secondary school.

The amount of credit that can be allowed for correspondence work will be determined later by competent authorities.

The each unit of credit obtained will be considered of equal value with a similar unit of credit obtained/through regular courses of upper secondary school.

Article 12. Articles 23, 27, 28, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62 and 63 of the Regulations for the Enforcement of the School Education Law shall be applicable to high school correspondence education.

Supplementary Provisions:

Article 13. This Ministerial Ordinance shall be applicable as from April 1, 1948.

Article 14. The competent authorities mentioned in these regulations shall, for the time being, be the Minister of Education in case the area stated in Item 2 of Article 2 covers the whole country, and the prefectural governor concerned in other cases.

Article 15. Ministry of Education Ordinance No. 24 of 1947 shall be abolished.

Article 16. The correspondence students according to Ministry of Education Ordinance No. 24 of 1947 shall be regarded as the correspondence students of an upper secondary school after 1 April 1, 1948.




