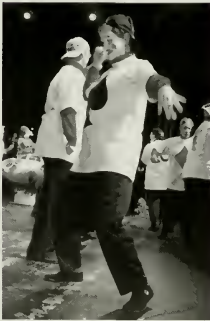
January 28, 2004

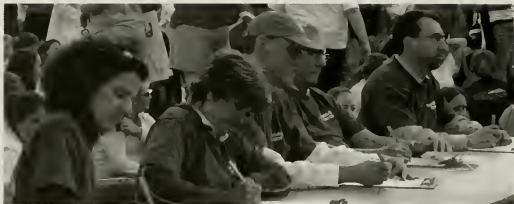

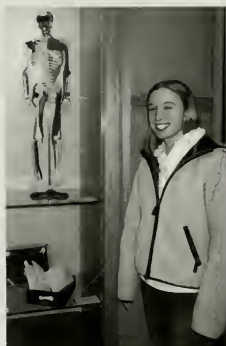

February 16 marked Meredith College Founder's Day. Students, staff and faculty attended a convocation honoring the 2003-2004 medieval theme. The European group,

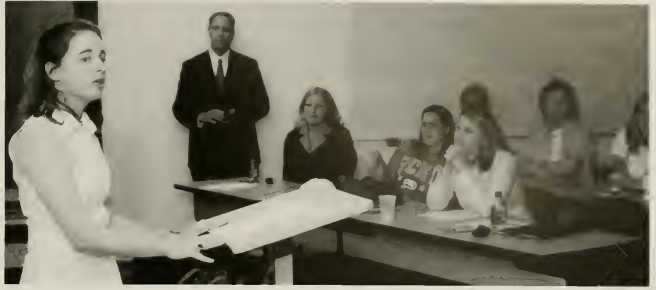
