At prices herein listed, all bulbs are prepaid anywhere in the U. S. and Canada and all countries in the Postal Union. The packages (Pkg.) bulb-lets contain a quantity proportionate to the 100 or 1000 price, while not counted in the cheaper kinds, you will find the count most generous. Remember we will take back any item that fails to please you and return your money. For our rating we refer to any Bank or Business house of Hamburg, N. Y., to Duns or Bradstreets, or the Florists Credit Association.

**SIZES:** We list sizes, Machine graded, all grades Standard. Bulblets washed clean and free from chaff and dirt and sold by dry measure. Our stock has been grown on new land, disinfected as a precaution, and rogued with care. We believe our stock the best that money can purchase. Where we abbreviate as Prim.-Grand. this indicates the large flowered Primilinus Grandiflorus.

**STATE INSPECTION:** License No. 2654. All stock inspected under the Farms and Market Laws of N. Y. State. All Canadian Shipments get special inspection before shipment, also invoices in triplicate form.

**DELIVERY:** Quotations are for spring delivery. We accept orders for fall delivery, but as we dig stock late it is not as well cured as we like to have it before shipment is made. March and April are best months for safe shipment. If we are to ship in cold weather, we must send via Express as Parcel Post does not insure against freezing. If sold out of size ordered we will send next size smaller unless you request us not to do so.

**DISCOUNTS:** See our Present for Cash. This will be a very generous discount on all CASH orders over \$5.00. Remember we will double this offer on all cash orders received before Jan. 1, 1930. The value of the Present for Cash will be from 5% up to 20% of your order depending on value of same. The 20% will be for orders over \$100.00 and will consist mainly of our originations.

**AFLAME** (Hornberger) 1925. Prim-Grand. National prize-winner, the colossus of its type, strong plant, heavy dark green foliage, strong straight spike, six to eight large well placed flowers open at once, often six inches or more. Wonderful color, begonia rose shading to a bright orange flame near edges of petals, back of petals even brighter. Has won at all the leading shows this season. This variety received fifth place in a vote of the Conn. Glad. society symposium. We will meet all other wholesale prices on this variety.

**BEN HUR** (Hornberger) 1929. Fine strong plant, wonderful self color, a clear royal purple, very large flowers, six or more open, outstanding color.

**BLUE TORCH** (Hornberger) 1925. An improved Ewbank, quite early, tall straight spike, fine commercial, in good demand. Color class pale violet.

**BROWN WINGS** (Hornberger) 1929. Large Prim-grand, combination shades of brown. A very unusual and outstanding color, very rare among glads.

**BUFFALO** (Hornberger) 1930. New deep red self, very strong tall plant, extra dark green foliage, flowers an intense blood red, very large with six to eight open at one time.

**HAMBURG PINK** (Hornberger). A very strong large new pink, a real florist's color, a shade deeper than Rita Beck, six to eight very large flowers open at one time, splendid keeper and shipper, rapid propagator, winner at Los Angeles show 1929, in its color class. This variety is quite early.

**IVANHOE** (Hornberger) 1929. A very strong growing variety. A deep bright salmon pink, self color, florets extra large, remarkable substance, six or more open, extra fine.

**MISS NEW YORK** (Hornberger) 1929. Very outstanding new pink, we would call it a peach pink self, large flowers six or more open, wonderful substance, a real beauty.

**MRS. CATHERINE EDWARDS** (Hornberger). New tall, early cream white, flowers in 70-75 days under good conditions, it is a massive show flower, eight to ten open. We have had flowers  $5\frac{1}{2}$  to 6 inches.

**RADIANT QUEEN** (Hornberger) Prim-Grand. Extra early, large flowered, a new glorified "Orange Queen," orange shading into saffron.

**PINK SHOW** (Hornberger) New 1930. Very tall strong plant, 10 to 14 medium sized flowers open at a time, a wonderful shade of light pink, coloring similar to "Mrs. O. W. Halliday."

**SALMON GLOW** (Hornberger) Prim-Grand. D. for balance due on same: We have discontinued all credit business.

**CASH IN FULL:** Before goods are shipped. This has nothing to do with your credit standing or rating, it is a plan to give you better service, to give you the highest quality, healthy true to name stock at the lowest cash prices and in addition to prepay same wherever the Parcel Post goes.
