



The above PLAN Exhibits the shape and form of a Body of Land containing Twenty-three acres and Four-tenths of an acre, of High-land and Marsh, part of a Tract granted by the Lords Proprietors unto Samuel Wragg Merchant for 25 acres on the 21st day of March 1715. Situated on the North side of Manigault alias Boundary Street, Charleston-Neck, in S^t Philip's Parish Charleston-District and State of South Carolina &c. — Which said Body of Land of 23 acres & 4/10 of an acre was late the property of Joseph — Wragg Esq^r dec^d and is now laid out into Sixty-nine Lots, and said lots are now divided between M^{rs} Charlotte Poaug & Joseph Manigault Esquire to wit. The Lots Numbered, in the above plan, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, 25, 26, 28, 29, 30, 32, 33, 35, 36, 37, 40, 41, 42, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63 and 69; making in the whole Forty-six Lots, drawn by and are now belonging to the said M^{rs} Charlotte Poaug; and the Lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 15, 16, 17, 18, 23, 27, 31, 34, 38, 39, 43, 49, 50, 51, 64, 65, 66, and 67, in all Twenty-three Lots, drawn by and are now belonging to the said Joseph Manigault Esquire. Having such Courses, distances, bounds, and Marks as expressed and represented by this Plan.
