PREFACE.

THE Poor Rate Book of Norwich, now printed and returned by me to its real owners, the Corporation, was bought by me a few months ago, and consists of 45 pp. fo. in a parchment cover, endorsed "No. 3, from Easter, 1633, to Easter, 1634."

This series, of which vols. 2 and 3 are unluckily lost, probably began in 1630, when the plague broke out in St. Gregory's parish, and we are told (Blomefield's "Norfolk," iii., p. 377) that £114 18s. 10d. was gathered in the City, to buy corn for the poor, which collection was continued for some years as long as the scarcity lasted.

There is a parcel containing a summary of the Poor Rate in 1572, in the Castle Mument Room (case A, shelf B), where there are also parcels containing summary of Poor Rate for the City from 1677 to 1687, and a parcel containing the names of the poor in 1709.

In case 20, shelf C, are two volumes, "The Mayors booke of the Poore;" and another from 1571 to 1579, and 1571 to 1580.

The roll now printed will be of great value to the genealogist, for it is more than twenty years earlier than the Hearth Tax Rolls, preserved at the Record Office, and seventy-seven years earlier than our first Norwich Poll Book of 1710.

Unluckily there is no statement on the face of the book as to whether the amounts collected were weekly or monthly.

On p. 37 the cash column is headed "weekly," but on p. 84 the collection is "monthly;" while, on p. 33, "Shops and grounds" in St. Peter Mancroft were collected quarterly.*

* The reader must not assume that because the figures in the margin do not cast up correctly with those given in detail in the text, the text is necessarily incorrect, for the marginal figures are sometimes varied and added to, possibly after the first casting.

Consequently, any comparisons of the relative sums paid by different people must be received with great caution, but, taking 4*d.* as the collection in respect of a large house, it is interesting to tabulate the results, which show that St. Peter Mancroft was the parish in which was far the greatest number of these important houses—viz., 34—St. Andrew's having 14; St. George, Timberhill, and St. Stephen's, 11; and St. Gregory's, 10; while no less than nine of the parishes had no house which paid the 4*d.*, whether it was weekly, monthly, or otherwise.

The highest rated house was that of Mrs. Prudence Blosse, in St. Saviour's, rated at 18*d.* Sir Peter Gleane's house in St. Peter Mancroft, Mr. Robt. Craske's in St. John Maddermarket, Mr. Francis Smalpece's in St. George Colegate, and Mr. Thomas Herring's of Heigham being rated at 12*d.* Mr. Throckmerton's in St. Paul's, and Mr. Augustus Skottow's at St. Peter Hungate, at 10*d.*; and Mr. Anguish's at Tombland at 9*d.*

The last house is in existence (in the occupation of Dr. Allen), so we can judge as to what those which are higher rated were like.

Mrs. Blosse, by her will, dated the same year as the rate book, gave her houses in St. Saviour's to the Corporation, to the intent that they might place widows in them to dwell rent free, and also gave £100 to the Children's Hospital; so it may be that the house or houses for which she was rated so highly was already some sort of hospital, or that she voluntarily agreed to a high assessment for charitable reasons.

The various statements at the head of various parishes, *e.g.* on p. 12, St. Julian's, "4*s* of St. Mich: at Plea," I apprehend, mean that some poor parishioner of St. Michael's at Plea

was temporarily resident in St. Julian's, who received a contribution from the parish to which he belonged.

The directions that certain children should be "put forth" apprentice or "to service," show that the Churchwardens and Overseers looked after the expenditure closely. The gifts or allowances to the poor are frequently conditional (*e.g.* p. 16) that the man or his wife do not beg.

The entry under St. Peter Southgate of John Whittam, "Fearnnothing Maker," is curious as suggesting the manufacture in the City of a garment akin to the modern "oily" or "dreadnaught."

Some few topographical notes may be gleaned, *e.g.* the Lion House and the Ten Acre Close are mentioned at Eaton, pp. 24, 25.

The surnames and their corruptions are very curious. "Vartingoose," on p. 25, was probably the name corrupted on p. 38 to "Rottengoose." Cookoe and Cucko probably came from the Dutch Cocquetu.

Halfknight (p. 54) is a survival of the old Norman-French name of Demi-chevalier, not uncommon in old records. Snoden (p. 57) gives an explanation of how the Welsh-sounding name of Snowdon came into Norwich.

The following is as complete a list as I can suggest of the French, Dutch, and Walloon surnames which occur in it. They number about ninety-three of the names of the rate-payers and poor, which, roughly speaking, come to about 1250.


