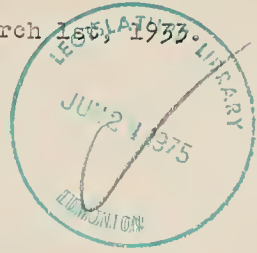

GASOLINE TAX.

During the calendar year, 1932, the sum of \$2,057,110.51 was collected.

A Commission of 2½% is paid to the Oil Companies as Agents in collecting the tax, which amounted to \$48,104.35. The refunds made on account of the purposes provided in the Statute amounted to \$443,190.92, leaving a net amount of \$1,565,815.94.
