# THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union, and in particular Article 31(2) thereof,

Having regard to Council Decision 2010/639/CFSP<sup>(1)</sup>, and in particular Article 4(1) thereof,

#### Whereas:

- (1) On 25 October 2010, the Council adopted Decision 2010/639/CFSP.
- (2) In view of the gravity of the situation in Belarus, certain persons should be included in Annex V to Decision 2010/639/CFSP.
- (3) The information relating to persons on the list in Annex IIIA to Decision 2010/639/ CFSP should be updated.
- (4) Annexes IIIA and V to Council Decision 2010/639/CFSP should be amended accordingly,
