 surrender, I was in the Rank of Lieutenant Colonel.
- 2. The TOBU Army document No. 41 dated 2 October 1942, and entitled "Matters concerning the employment of POW" (Exhibit No. 1967) was issued when I was Staff-officer in the TOBU Army. This was made on the basis of two different documents, one being "Matters concerning"

the Treatment of POW! (Exhibit No. 1965-1) which was decided by the
Minister of War and the after being "POW Employment Regulations"

(Exhibit No. 3050) which had already been aftered at that time.

The document "Matters concerning the employment of POW" did not contain any plan of employing prisoners of war in the labor directly connected with military operations such as production and transportation of arms and ammunition. As a matter of fact at no time were prisoners of kind of war employed in such labor as mentioned above.
