 - The entire village was burning when the planes broke off the attack. Ho military installations were observed but most of the little houses were sot afire. One pilot also reported he was nearly certain that two trucks were caught in the village and burned.
 - 2. The VF led in a daisy chain against a mumber of scattered trucks in the vicinity of Inasom. Two of the trucks were set aftre and destroyed. Others were hit but did not burn, and the extent of the damage could not be observed. A large fire from an undetermined source was started in area 8066.

4 VF with 4 VT from VC-13 and 4 VT from VC-93 launched as one group for disset aircraft support of ground troops on Okinama.

The first mission assigned was to "shoot up" the little village of Kokuda in area 7669 which was reported to contain enemy concentrations. The attack was made principally with rockets and strafing and when the attack was completed the entire village was aftre. Any enemy installations in the village were certainly destroyed.

After this attack was emploted the Air Coordinator led the whole flight in one big daisy chain shooting up trucks in areas 7964, 8065, 8066 and 8166 around the village of Inason. The VF definitely set two trucks afire and others were hit and undoubtedly damaged. A large fire was also started in area 8066 but the pilots could not ascertain what was burning.
