

Why Wikipedia?

Wikipedia is is a free, multilingual online encyclopedia written and maintained by a community of volunteer contributors through a model of open collaboration, using a wiki-based editing system.

7th most visited website in the world!

320+ languages (all with differing content)





Why women?

Over 80% volunteers are men, which leads to issues of the balance of gender-related content.

Percentage of women's biographies on English Wikipedia:

2015 - 15.5%

2024 - 19.9%

Learn to edit Wikipedia, collaborating with others online to change the internet.






What's the impact?
