Wikisource: content/proofreading

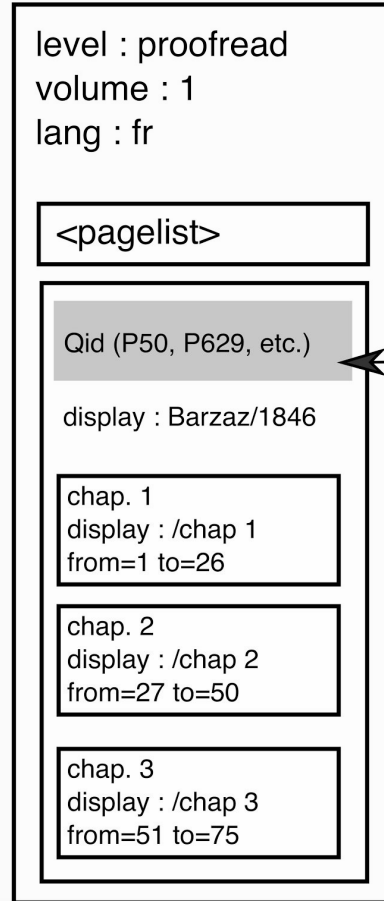




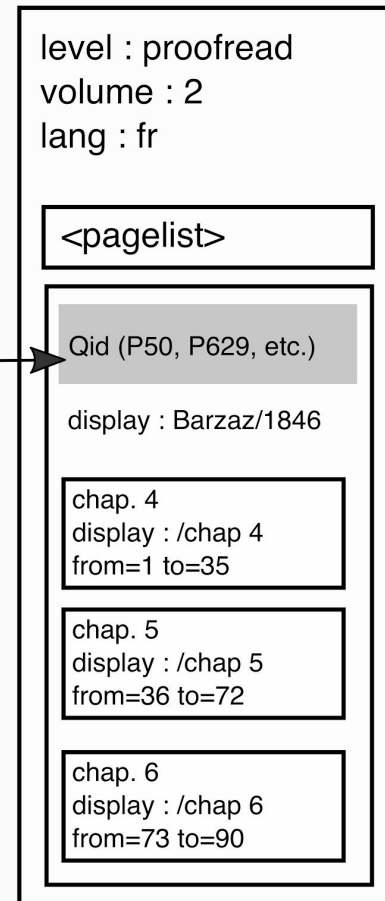
