Emily Burling Waite

Miss Waite was born in Worcester in 1887. She studied at the School of the Worcester Art Museum in 1905-6 under Mr. Philip L. Hale and Mr. Hermann Dudley Murphy, winning the scholarship offered by the Art Students' League of New York in 1906. In 1906-7-8 Miss Waite studied at the Art Students' League in New York, receiving an honorable mention in the Life Class. The years 1908-9-10 were spent at the Museum of Fine Arts School, Boston. In 1908 Miss Waite won the second and third concours, the Ellen Gardner prize, and the Helen K. Hamlin Scholarship.

During the second year Miss Waite again won the three concours, the Sears Prize and the Paige Traveling Scholarship for two years. In 1910-11-12 she travelled and studied in England, France, Belgium, Holland, Germany, Austria, Italy and Spain. She exhibited at the Salon des Beaux Arts in the spring of 1911. After her return to America Miss Waite exhibited at most of the important exhibitions of 1912-13.
