SUBJECT : Distribution of Community Chest Fund.

- (1) The Toyama-Ken Community Chest Commission, deciding the collection goal of ¥11,500,000 for community chest and that of ¥3,500,000 for the Red Cross fund, totalling ¥15,000,000, began its prefecture-wide drive on Oct. 1, 1949 through the campaign period lasting Oct. 31, 1949.
- (2) All of the Ken-people showed their sincere cooperation to this love movement of red feather, as well as the rural 255 committees devoted their best service to the common object. As much as ¥15,035,953.52 were collected successfully upon the goal of ¥15,000,000.
- (3) After deliberation on distribution in the Distribution Subcommittee at Kencho from 9:00 a.m. till 6:00 p.m. on 19 Dec. 1949, the final plan for distribution was made up as to ¥10,059,000, excluding the expenses for publicity and preparatory conferences, and other items, and the portion to the Red Cross Assn.
- (4) On 24 Dec. 1949 the general membership meeting of the Commission was held at the Toyama City Office from 9:00 a.m. till 2:00 p.m., made a deliberation upon the submitted plan and came to the unanimous conclusion as stated in the annexed distribution list.
- (5) This distribution plan is regarded, on the part of Ken authorities, as almost appropriate, and we respectfully request that C.A.R. authority investigates.
