1. Reference is made to:

a. Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers File AG 370.05 (7 May 1946) GC (SCAPIN 927) dated 7 May 1946, subject: Repatriation, as amended.

- b. Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers File AG 014.33 (18 September 1046) GC (SCAPIN 1214) dated 18 September 1046, subject: Repatriation of Japanese from Hawaii, Philippines, Okinawa, the Marianas Islands and the Caroline Islands.
- 2. The following nationals will arrive at Uraga on 27 October 1946 aboard the vessel "James Wing":

Chinese - 3

Indo-Chinese - 7

Formosan - 24

Manchurian - 1

- 3. Transportation has not yet arrived for repatriation of these nationals. Until such time as transportation is arranged, the Imperial Japanese Government will make necessary arrangements to care for these nationals.
- 4. The Imperial Japanese Government will be notified when transportation is available for the above named personnel.
