THE NORTHERN MAIL failed yesterday beyond Charleston.

The FAIRY. — The report of the Board of Health for the week shows that 17 cases of yellow fever were admitted into the Charity Hospital, and that 7 were discharged.

Dr. S. We are pleased to add, that there are abundant proofs to prove that the fever is about to prevail as an epidemic. On Sunday, there were 14 admissions into the Charity Hospital, of which 2 were of yellow fever, and 4 deaths, of which 2 were of that disease. Yesterday evening, up to 10 o'clock, there were 22 admissions, of which 8 were yellow fever, and 5 deaths, of which 4 were of the same disease.

In addition to this, we heard that several cases were admitted into Dr. Stone's Hospital, besides a few others in private practice.

The number of deaths by yellow fever, reported to the Board of Health, for the week ending on Saturday, was 13.

DEATH.—An infant of honor took place on Saturday between two gentlemen of this city, one of them connected with the British. At the first fire of the pistol, the bullet struck his antagonist's ball in the side, the half striking the ribs and glanced round and through at the opposite side. The wounded party is likely to do well.

One or two other duels were on the tops, but have, we understand, been arrested by timely interference.
