Rules of the Game

Writing software and achieving our goals is a **team sport**

- None of us is a genius. :) If we want to have output that has impact, we need to work together.
- Hiding is considered harmful (both for productivity purposes as well as for the bus factor)
- Lose self-ego, develop team-pride
- Criticize without questioning someone's character/self and allow to be criticized
- Be patient
- Be open to be influenced

Too many rules to remember?

Remember the following three fundamental pillars

- **Humility**

you are not the center of the world. You're open to self-improvement.

- **Respect**

You truly care about others you work with. You treat them as human beings and appreciate their abilities and accomplishments.

- **Trust**

you believe others are competent and will do the right thing, and you are OK with letting them drive when appropriate.

Improved communication in the team

Clear sense of direction, things to do, and things not to do.

The process of arriving at the mission is as important as the mission itself.

- To arrive at a shared understanding of why we are in WLM international team
- To make sure everyone in the team moves toward the same direction
- To be able to identify the problems that we want to work on
- And to be able to say no to the problems that we don't want to work on
