On 6/28/61, PG 612-C advised SA THOMAS G. FORSYTH, III:

In the past ten days three men were beaten/severely in New Kensington, Pa. Each of these men were delinquent in the payment of gambling debts owed to the MANNARINO organization, and as has been the traditional manner of handling such cases, each was attacked by at least two of the "strong-arm" collectors, probably SONNY CIANCUTTI and ANDY MANGINI. The identities of the beaten men are not known, but even if they were, these men would not cooperate with any law enforcement agency due to the fear of further beatings and because of the prevalent belief that the MANNARINO organization "owns" the police.

One reason for the spate of beatings may be attributed to a rumored shortage of cash in the MANNARINO organization. It is said in gambling circles that the gambling play has been so slow for the past two months that the "boys" are getting close to the point of desperation.

BOTH SUBJECTS SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.
