Lighthouse 75 feet high; the light stands 100 feet above the sea -
 revolves once every minute - may be seen 15 miles - and
 shews from N.N.W. to S.E. by E. (Mag.)

H.W.F. & C.P. 55^m. Springs rise 6. Neaps 4 feet.
