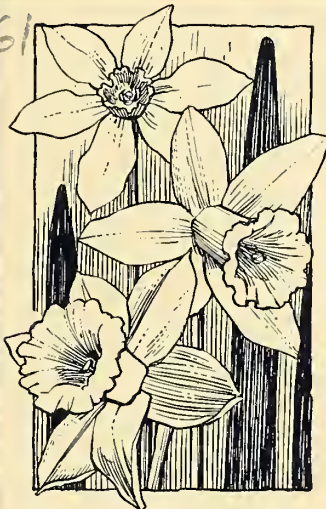
This quarantine has now been modified, so we are able to offer once more a wide selection of first quality French and Holland bulbs.
