WASHINGTON LETTER.
From Our Special Correspondent.
It is difficult to predict accurately from the debate on the Hawaiian annexation treaty will end, nor will the discussion be in it, but it is taken place in executive session, behind closed doors. What the final result will be is also uncertain at this writing. The latest and most reliable poll shows that fifty senators favor the treaty, while thirty-three oppose it, which would indicate probable failure of the treaty. The administration expects to secure the four additional votes required to make the necessary two-thirds from the ranks of the seven or eight senators who are now publicly opposed. These gains, however, are not likely to be made. Senator McMillan of Idaho has been one of those, but recently came out in favor of annexation. Party lines are not drawn upon it, though, as reported, the senator will vote for the treaty. Twenty-nine of the opponents are democrats, three republicans and one silver republican. The debate will undoubtedly be interesting and the proposition to throw open the doors and let the discussion go on in open session may finally prevail. It is not now expected that a vote will be reached before March.

The assertion is made by Congressman Louder that the exclusion of serial publications and sample copies of newspapers from the privileges of second class postage rates would effect a saving to the government of \$10,000,000 a year. Friends of the measure which Mr. Louder has introduced claim that these two items comprise the source of the deficit in the revenues of the postal service, but that there is no serious amount of mail carried entirely free under congressional and departmental demands that it be cut off. It was never intended or expected that the postal service would be self-supporting. The people desire the better of the two parties to get for it. The Louder bill has some good features, but it is not perfect and will not pass in its present shape.

At some of the hotels in Washington where congressmen and their families are quartered the social functions include regular weekly card parties, progressive euchre, etc., at which their friends from the other houses are invited. These games, with their prizes and other inducements, are great contests in which the deepest interest is taken by both men and women. Interference from both sexes annoys them. 
