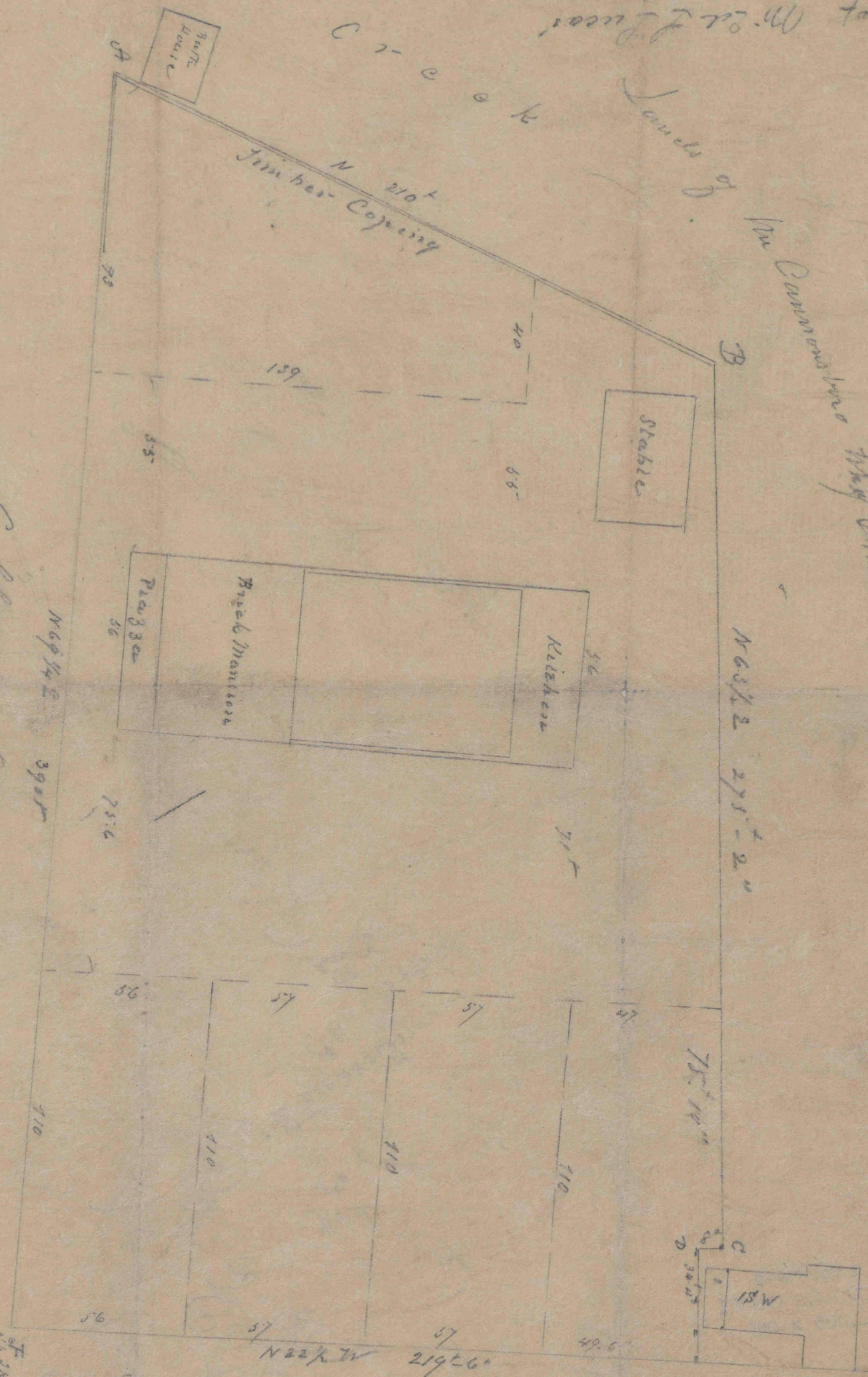

The line DC is an encroachment of about 8' on Mr. Lucas' lot - Mr. Parkes Survey of 1851 being my authority

In this plan Home has made some alterations from 2 to C. This plan is drawn on the wrong side of the fence as he had no authority for his line & as his occupation he should have been followed it - as it is well understood that occupation extends from both sides only to the boards of the fence
