PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of December 1969, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (Rein) in defense of the DA NANG Vital Area and in other operations throughout QUANG NAM Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division and Force Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, ROKMC, CIDG, and ARVN forces.

The month was characterized by a fairly consistent, but relatively low, level of enemy activity. The only significant enemy actions were small scattered and ineffective attacks by fire. The attacks by fire against the DA NANG Vital Area and 11th Marines units included one rocket attack and one road mining incident.

On 110037 December 1969, Marine personnel at the DA NANG airstrip reported rockets impacting vicinity grid BT010750. Just prior to that time three counter-rocket observation posts reported sightings which intersected at grid AT969690. A total of 162 mixed caliber artillery rounds were fired at the suspected grid. Immediate results were two secondary explosions, and a sweep of the area by an infantry squad found one (1) killed enemy and various clothing. The Crater Analysis Team investigation disclosed six (6) confirmed impacts, possibly 2 others, and all were identified as 140mm rockets.

Rainfall lessened during the month but still caused a general degradation of ground activity throughout the Division's TAOR.

During December apparently one of the enemy's goals continued to be collection of rice and other foodstuff and to establish storage sites. An extensive rice denial program continued in effect throughout the month by the 1st Marine Division and the 11th Marines in an attempt to halt or hinder NVA/VC rice-collecting actions and to keep them in the high grounds and mountains.

Previous intelligence sources had indicated that the enemy would launch a major offensive in November to continue through early December. That action failed to materialize. Various intelligence sources now report, and indications support, that the enemy is still in Phase I of his winter/spring (TET) offensive. During this phase the enemy plans to gather and store rice, regroup and rearm, and rest his troops for the more active Phases II and III.

Though the enemy declined to initiate any further ground actions, there were many sightings of large groups of NVA/VC made during the month. In 21 of these sightings there were 20 or more NVA/VC. This is double the amount observed in November.

For a listing of significant fire missions see Part III paragraph (2) Intelligence.

During the month, there were three major artillery moves within the Regiment. A detachment from 3rd 175mm Guns at AN HOA Combat Base displaced two tubes to HILL 34 and one tube to the NORTHERN ARTILLERY CAMPMENT; all three weapons became OPCON role to 1st 175mm Guns. On 4 December, two 155

Howitzers (Towed) from Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines at Fire Support Base LOS BANOS displaced to HILL 10 in support of a 26th Marine operation in SHERWOOD FOREST; on 9 December, they displaced back to LOS BANOS. Four tubes of Battery G, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines were helo-lifted from LZ ROSS to FSB BUSHWHACK in the QUE SON Mountains.

The six (6) Integrated Observation Devices (IOD) emplaced throughout the Division continued to achieve considerable success. During the month they were accredited with 421 enemy kills. This amounted to 93.8 percent of the EKIA's accredited to artillery and 41.7 percent of all EKIA's in the Division TAOR during December.

The Regimental Survey section was unable to calibrate any weapons during the month of December because the M-36 chronographs were deadlined for lack of parts. It is anticipated that unit calibration will be able to commence during early January 1970.

A total of 163,574 rounds were expended on 14,421 missions during the month of December, 1969. Artillery fires accounted for 449 of the 1010 confirmed kills within the Division TAOR during the same period. Besides the normal missions, such as contact missions, intelligence targets, rocket and mortar suppression fires, pre-emptive fires and preparation fire, artillery was also employed in an effort to neutralize areas containing Surprise Firing Devices used by the enemy.

Unannounced OP and counter-rocket drills continued nightly throughout the month. Chart operators, observation post personnel, fire direction center personnel, gun crews and communicators derived invaluable benefits and increased their skills as a result of these drills. The average response time was two minutes to get fire on a counter-rocket grid.

Extensive efforts continued throughout the 11th Marine Regiment to repair damages and to minimize effects of light-to-medium rains and flooding conditions on ordnance, units' facilities and motor transport during the month of December 1969.

2. Intelligence

a. Enemy activity continued to decrease for the fourth month in a row. The only significant enemy actions were small, scattered and ineffective attacks by fire. The attacks by fire against DA NANG Vital Area and 11th Marines units included one road mining incident and one incident of eight rounds of 140mm rocket fire directed at DA NANG Air Base.

b. The IOD, with six operating teams, continued to display its effectiveness, accounting for 421 kills out of the artillery total of 449.

c. Though the enemy failed to initiate any further ground activity, there were sightings of significant numbers of VC/NVA made during the reporting period, as illustrated by the following significant fire missions:

3. Organization and Operations

a. Units of the 11th Marines participated in no major operations during the month of December.

4. Training

a. Forward observer training for non-artillery personnel was again conducted during the month of December. Recipients of this training were personnel from Combined Action Groups, 1st Reconnaissance Battalion, 1st Tank Battalion and 7th Engineers. A total of 340 personnel received two to three hours of classroom instruction and four to six hours of practical application.

b. During the month, 11th Marines sent to Division Schools two officers and 12 enlisted Marines. The officers attended the Officer Leadership Course while four of the enlisted Marines attended NCO Leadership School. Four Marines also attended the Career Planning Orientation course. One Marine was sent to each of the following schools: Projectionist School, Vietnamese Language School, Basic Infantry Weapons Repair School and Basic Ammunition Technician School.

5. Logistics

a. During the month of December motor vehicle deadline remained high. This was attributed to the deep mud prevalent during the northeast monsoon season.

b. Construction began on HILL 65 (AT883560) to prepare positions for three 175mm guns and two 8" howitzers. Construction consists of building five gun pads, ammunition bunkers, FDC bunker, and living quarters.

c. During the month two 8" howitzers were received and exchanged under the R and E program. The artillery deadline average was .8 percent. There were 6 days of the month when the deadline was 0 percent.

d. During December, vehicular augmentation was provided by 1st Marine Division to resupply Class V at Fire Support Base LOS BANOS and HILL 65. Additionally, both Division and organic vehicles logged increased mileage in providing routine support for artillery units at LZ BALDY and AN HOA Combat Base.

6. Civic Action Report for Headquarters Battery, 11th Marines

a. One building of DA SON Hamlet's permanent market place was completed on 14 December. Another building will be constructed on the remaining area. To aid in the completion, this office delivered fifteen, 100 lbs bags of cement, five, 4x4's; 38, 2x4's; 28 pieces of tin and three truck loads of sand to DA SON Hamlet.

b. DA SON Hamlet's sow was mated the week of 9-15 December. The boar, on loan from a 7th Engineer hamlet, was returned on 16 December.

c. On 27 December one of the two pregnant rabbits that was purchased to begin a breeding - selling project in DA SON Hamlet, delivered six offspring. It is not known when the other will deliver.

d. Two solatium payments this past month, one (2500\$VN) to a 26 year old female of DA SON Hamlet who was wounded in the right foot on 10 December by an unidentified Marine, and another payment (4000\$VN) was made to a family whose son was struck and killed by a motor vehicle from 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines.

e. Headquarters Battery, 11th Marine's 13 man liaison unit was formed and only awaits the district chief's approval before it moves into DA SON Hamlet on a permanent basis. Starting 1 January 1970 they will begin night-time activities in that Hamlet. If district approval is not forthcoming by then, the unit will return to the 11th Marines compound each morning. Night-time activities will be coordinated with the Northern Sector Defense Command and will be under the guidance of the S-5 office.

f. MEDCAP, held daily except Sunday and Wednesday from 1300 to 1500, treated 1025 villagers during the month of December. Infected lacerations and abrasions, infected ears, and colds, coughs and other minor lacerations and abrasions were most commonly treated.

g. Due to lack of response, DENTCAP is no longer held solely in DA SON Hamlet. DENTCAP visits the hamlets of BAI LAI, PHUOC HUOU, DA LA and THANH DINH on Fridays from 1300 to 1500. Dental treatment continued to be available to villagers of DA SON at the 11th Marines cantonment. DENTCAP treated 50 villagers this past month. Extraction of infected teeth and partially lost teeth constituted the majority of treatment.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO Unit continued to fly sorties during the month of December in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 194.5 hours of aircraft time and 165.6 hours of AO on-station time were recorded.

During the month, the AO unit was supported by light observation helicopters attached from Company A, 123rd Aviation Battalion, Americal Division, USA. In addition, UH-1E gunships from the 282nd Aviation Battalion, USA were provided as cover aircraft and flew a total of 28.9 hours in support of the 11th Marines AO unit. Ol-G "Birddogs" were provided for observation and registrations by 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC), USA. 35.4 hours were flown with 21st RAC. To provide additional coverage of the rocket belt, Helicopter Medium Light 167 (HLM 167) Squadron provided UH-1E's for observation. 20.3 hours were flown with HML 167.
