INTRODUCTION

On June 1, 1956 there were 138 cities, 612 towns and 1,123 incorporated villages in Canada. The first table in this report (Table 7) lists these incorporated centres in alphabetical arrangement, showing the township or municipality, etc., as well as the county or census division and province, in which each is located. Population totals from the 1951 Census (according to the boundaries in effect at that date) are shown for comparative purposes.

Included in this report are tables to show the 1956 Census population totals, with comparative figures for 1951, of (a) Census Metropolitan Areas and their component parts, (Table 8), and (b) localities classed in the census as Other Major Urban Areas (Table 9). For census purposes, metropolitan areas have been established for groups of urban communities in Canada which are in close economic, geographic and social relationship. The group of Other Major Urban Areas possess characteristics of metropolitan areas, but in most cases the cities are smaller in size.

INTRODUCTION

Le Canada comprenait, le 1^{er} juin 1956, 138 cités, 612 villes et 1,123 villages constitués. Le premier tableau du présent rapport (tableau 7) énumère ces centres constitués selon l'ordre alphabétique, indiquant le canton ou township ou la municipalité, etc., ainsi que le comté ou la division de recensement et la province où ils sont situés. Pour les besoins de la comparaison, sont donnés également les chiffres du recensement de 1951 (suivant les limites en vigueur à la date du recensement).

Le présent rapport contient des tableaux qui donnent les chiffres de la population recensée en 1956 et les chiffres comparatifs de 1951 pour: a) les zones métropolitaines de recensement et leurs parties intégrantes (tableau 8), et b) les localités classées au recensement sous la rubrique 'autres grandes agglomérations urbaines' (tableau 9). Pour les besoins du recensement, des groupes d'agglomérations urbaines, étroitement liées tant sur le plan économique que sur le plan géographique et social ont été constitués zones métropolitaines. Le groupe des 'autres grandes agglomérations urbaines' possède les caractéristiques propres aux zones métropolitaines mais, dans la plupart des cas, les cités sont de moindre taille.
