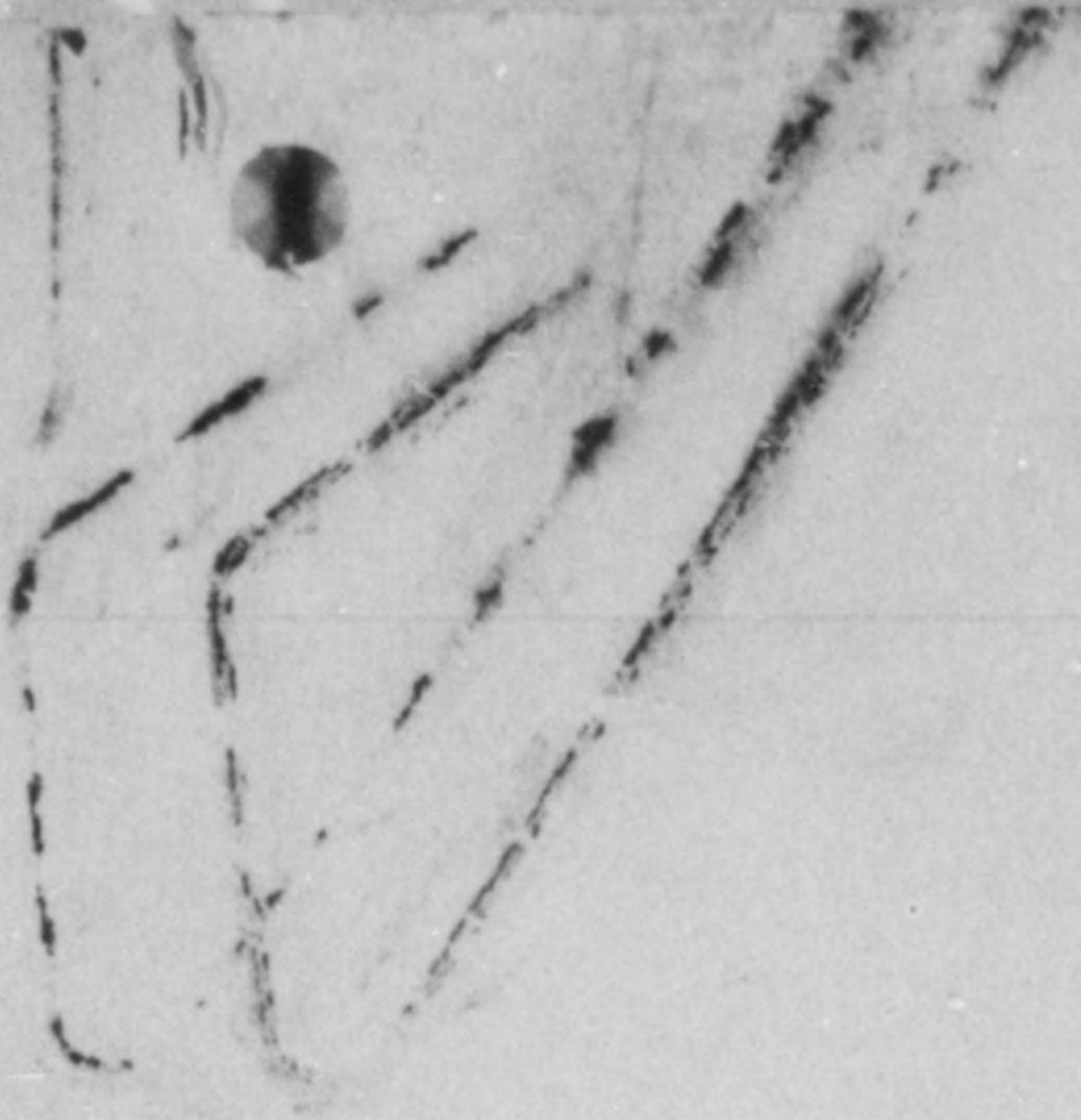

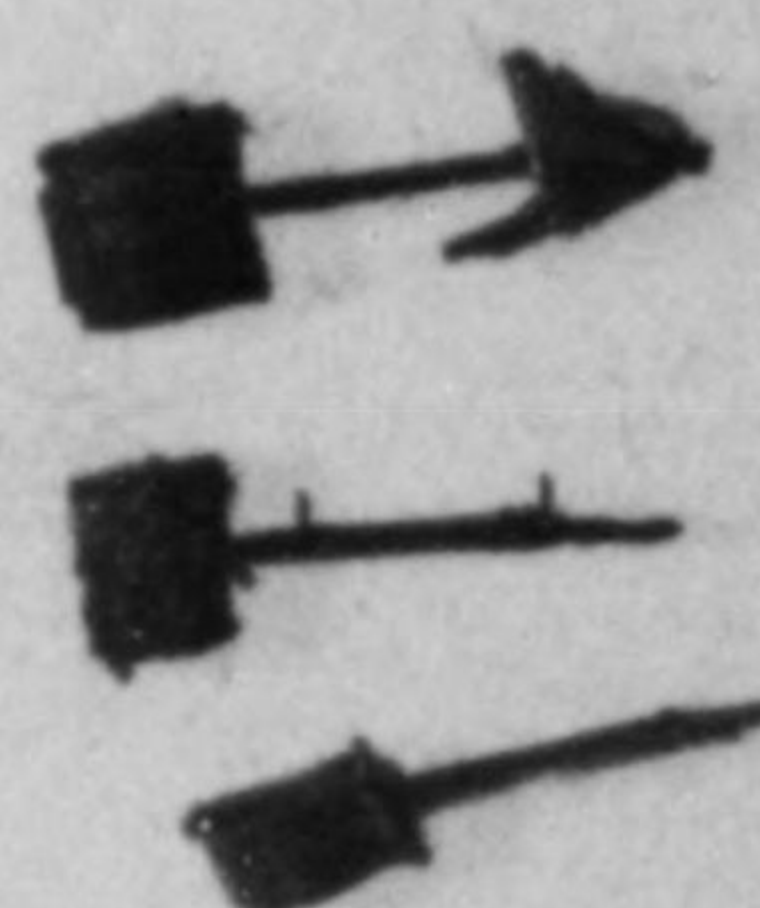

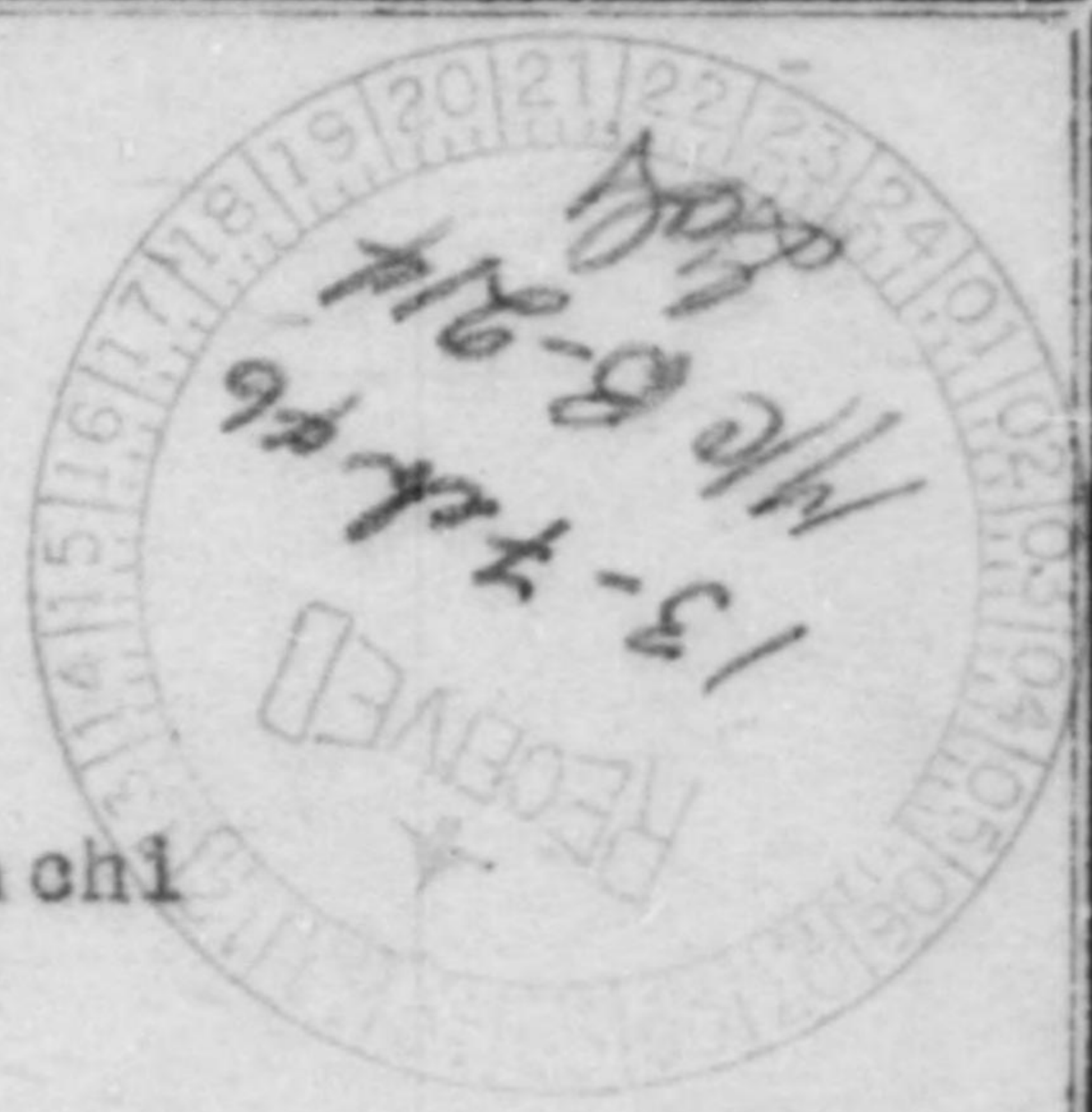

Subject: "Japanese B Encephalitis".

1. Pending revision of Circular 72, this headquarters, 3 May 1947, subject as above, the following instructions will apply in the conservation and administration of Japanese B Encephalitis vaccine and in obtaining the estimates of the amounts of vaccine needed in this command.

2. A refrigeration temperature of 5 degrees centigrade must be maintained for the vaccine during transmission, distribution and storage.

3. Utilization of total dosage in each ampule by arranging to vaccinate persons in groups of not less than 25. After adding the diluent, vaccine is very unstable and should be utilized as rapidly as possible. Vials are not usable after the end of the day in which opened.

4. The following personnel in Japan will be immunized.

a. All military personnel of the United States Army, Navy and Air Forces.

b. All United States civilian employees.

c. Dependents of above personnel on a voluntary basis.

d. British Forces, employees and dependents on a voluntary basis.

5. Three subcutaneous doses of one cubic centimeter will be administered. Children less than 6 months of age will not be immunized. Those between six months and one year of age should receive one-half the adult dose at the discretion of the

Medical Officer performing the immunization. The vaccination program will be started in Japan south of and including Osaka and Kyoto on or about 15 May 1948 and in remainder of Japan on or about 1 June 1948. Persons immunized during the 1946 or 1947 season will receive only one stimulating dose of one cubic centimeter subcutaneously administered at the time the other personnel in the same area are receiving their third or final dose. Personnel departing this command prior to 1 July will not be immunized. Personnel arriving prior to 1 August will be immunized. Those arriving after 1 August will receive the first two doses only. No immunization will be administered after 1 September. Transients, including crews of ships and aircraft will not be immunized.

6. Desire estimates of vaccine requirements based on above policy for immunization be furnished this headquarters not later than 25 March 1948. Reports will be submitted by radio and will be classified CONFIDENTIAL.

2 tablets every 4 hours.
