a. The memories of Lt. TAKAHASHI Manroku, Chief Gunnery Officer are as follows:

- (1) Some sixty foreigners (some forty English and Germans, and others including Chinese, Burmese and natives) were taken on board the subject vessel when it was operating in the sea-area of the Admiralty Islands, though he does not remember the date and place of their embarkation.
- (2) After the vessel left Kavieng, all these foreigners were shot to death on board the vessel.
- (3) He remembers that the execution was carried out in compliance with the telegraphic order issued by the superior headquarters.



According to the letter, his father received the following information concerning Sekio from Eiro ANDO who had been repatriated from Morotai:

- a. KAWAMURA, Sekio joined the Naval Special Police Corps with ANDO and was sent to Menado, Celebes Island, in February 1945.
- b. After the surrender of Japan KAWAMURA was incarcerated in a prison in Menado with the other members of the Special Police Corps.
- c. In December 1945 he was transferred to the POW Camp at Morotai Island and thereafter had served as a cook in the Camp without being examined.
- d. On 18 May 1946 he was again transferred to Menado for interrogation.

3. It is added that KAWAMURA's father also received the notification concerning KAWAMURA's detention in Morotai from the Local Assistance Bureau in Fukuoka addressed to the village headman of Shodai-mura, a copy of which and the English translation thereof are enclosed herewith.







a. Inspector Matao UCHIDA, Chief of the Miyaji Police Station, and Sub-Inspector Shigeru YAMASHITA, officer in charge of judicial affairs of the Station:

Their salaries reduced by 20 per cent for two months for the reasons that trusting the outward demeanour of the Suspected War Criminal, they detained him in the night-duty room and that they failed to give necessary instructions to their subordinates as to vigilance.

b. Haruo SAKAMOTO, constable in the guard-service at the Police Station:

His salary reduced by 10 percent for two months for the reason that he was a warden-policeman and was on watch at the time of the escape.

C. Kanayoshi FURUSHO, constable in the guard-service at the Police Station, and Saneharu YAMAMOTO, constable attached to the Station:

Their salaries reduced by 10 per cent for one month for the reasons that the former was working at the Station on patrol duty at the time of the escape, and that the latter was on night-duty on that day.
