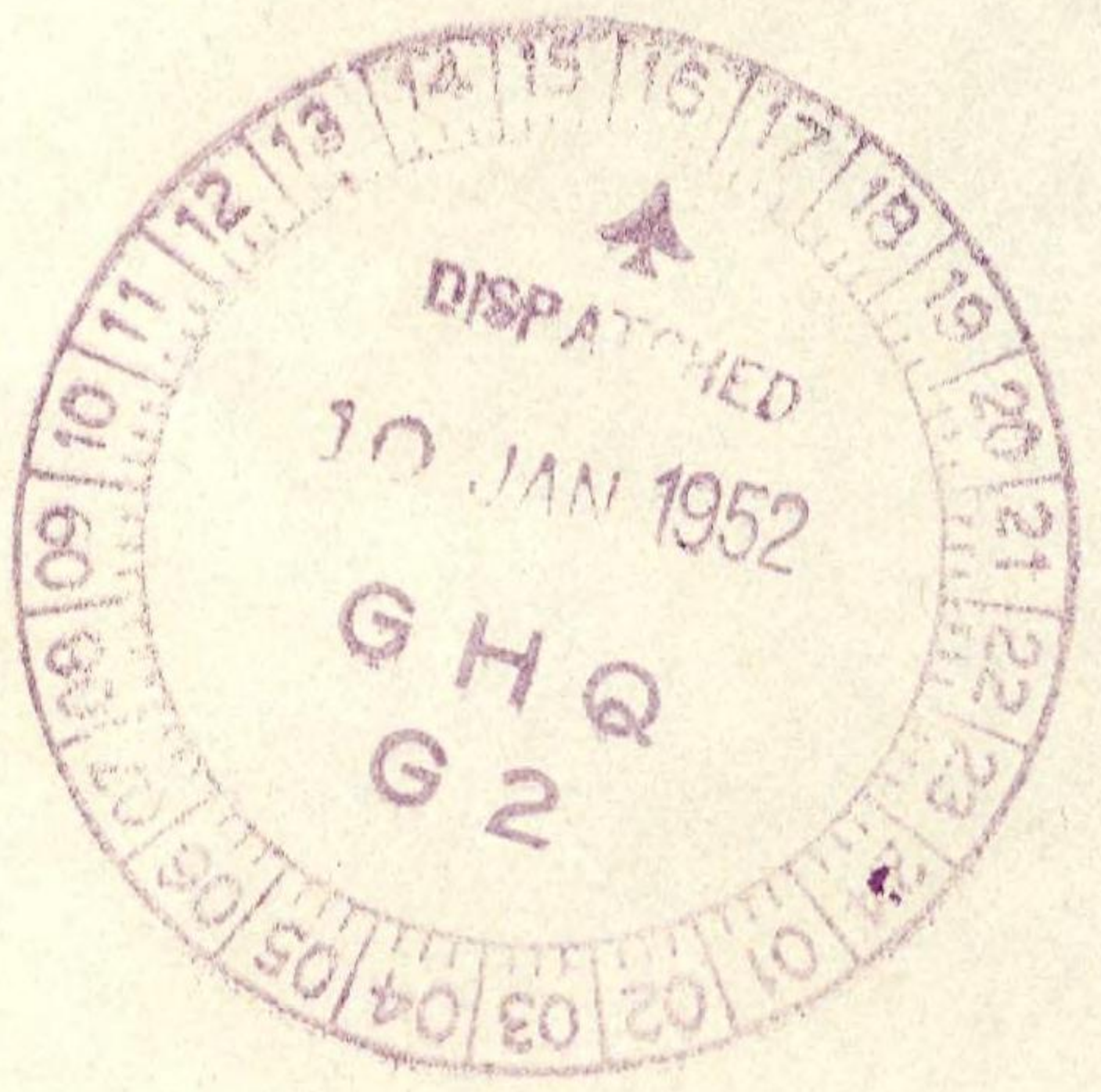

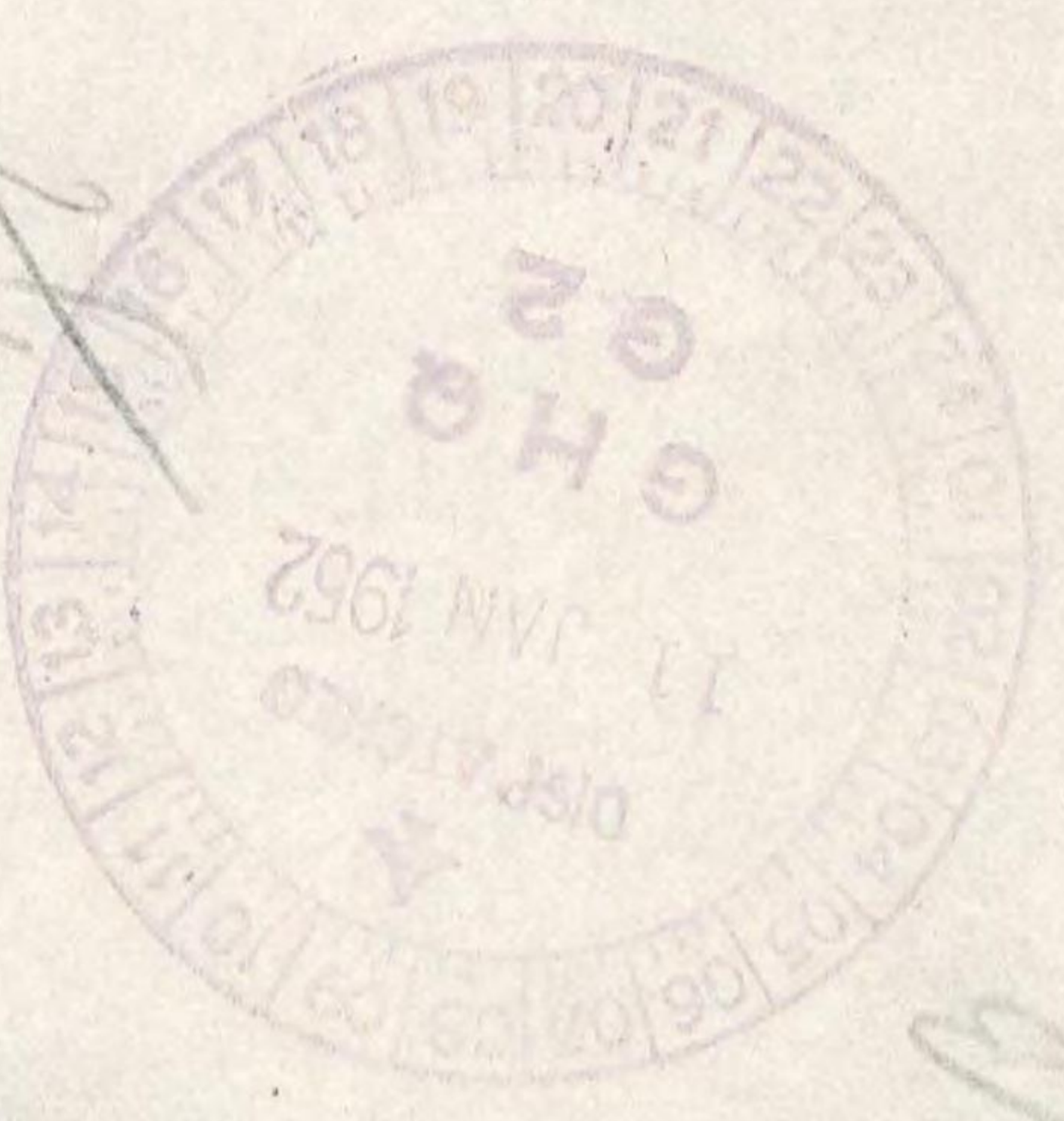

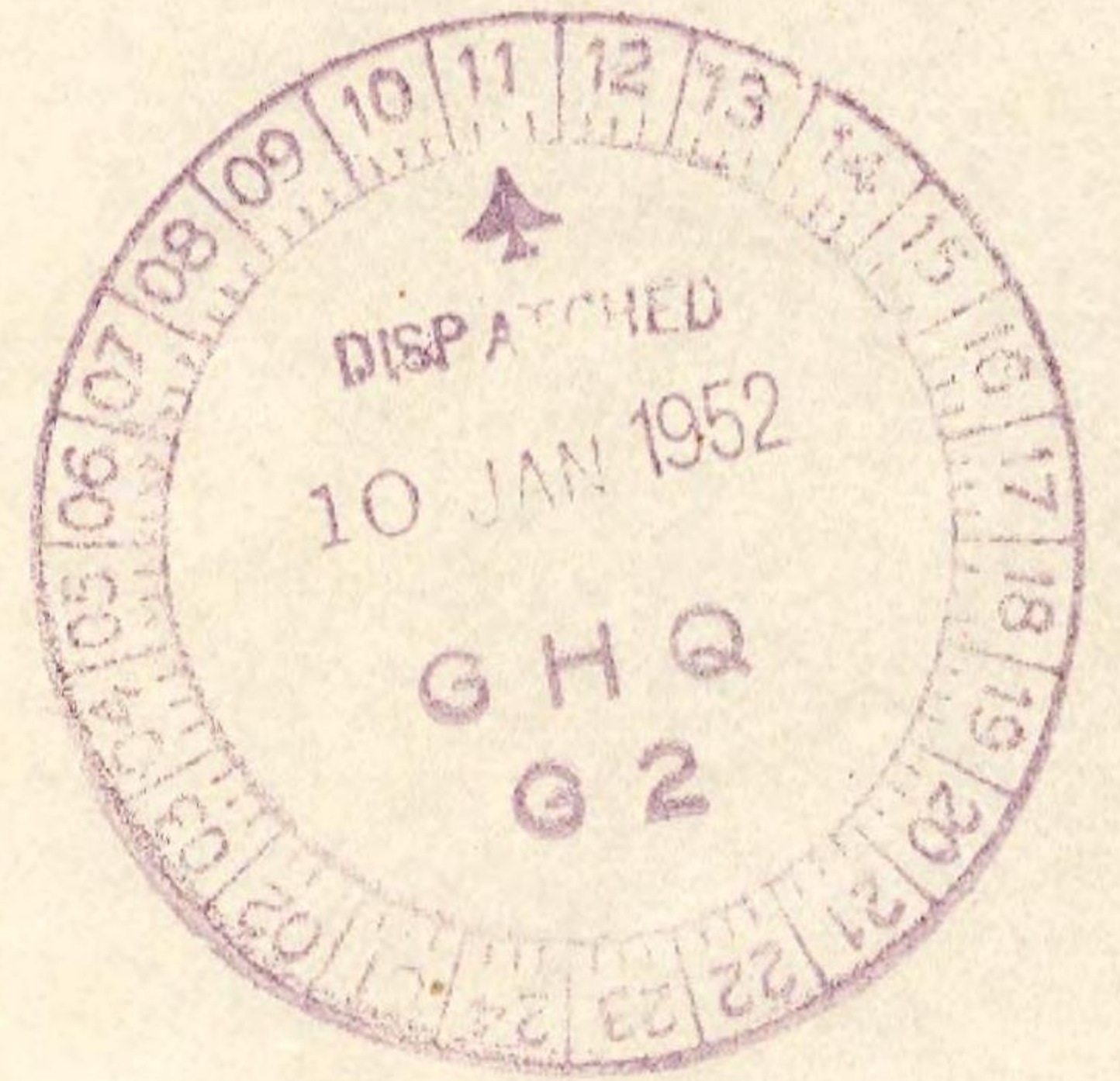

1. By separate actions Document Research Section has requested:
 - a. The assignment, on indefinite temporary duty, of eleven (11) military and one civilian, presently assigned to FEC/LG and on TDY with 441st C.I.C.
 - b. Authority to take control of the "Alphabetical Operations" and the "PSA Program" which were ordered transferred to 441st C.I.C.
2. Both of these papers were forwarded to G-2 thru 441st C.I.C. with recommendations from this office maintaining that the personnel and the operations should be kept together.
3. In conversation with General Ennis-Col Blakeney-Lt Col Canon on or about 28 Dec 1951, concurrence with a short (several months) temporary duty assignment was given. It was tacitly agreed that the TDY should not in any event continue longer than such a time as would permit Lt Col Canon to return to the ZI in time to attend the next class at the PMG school.

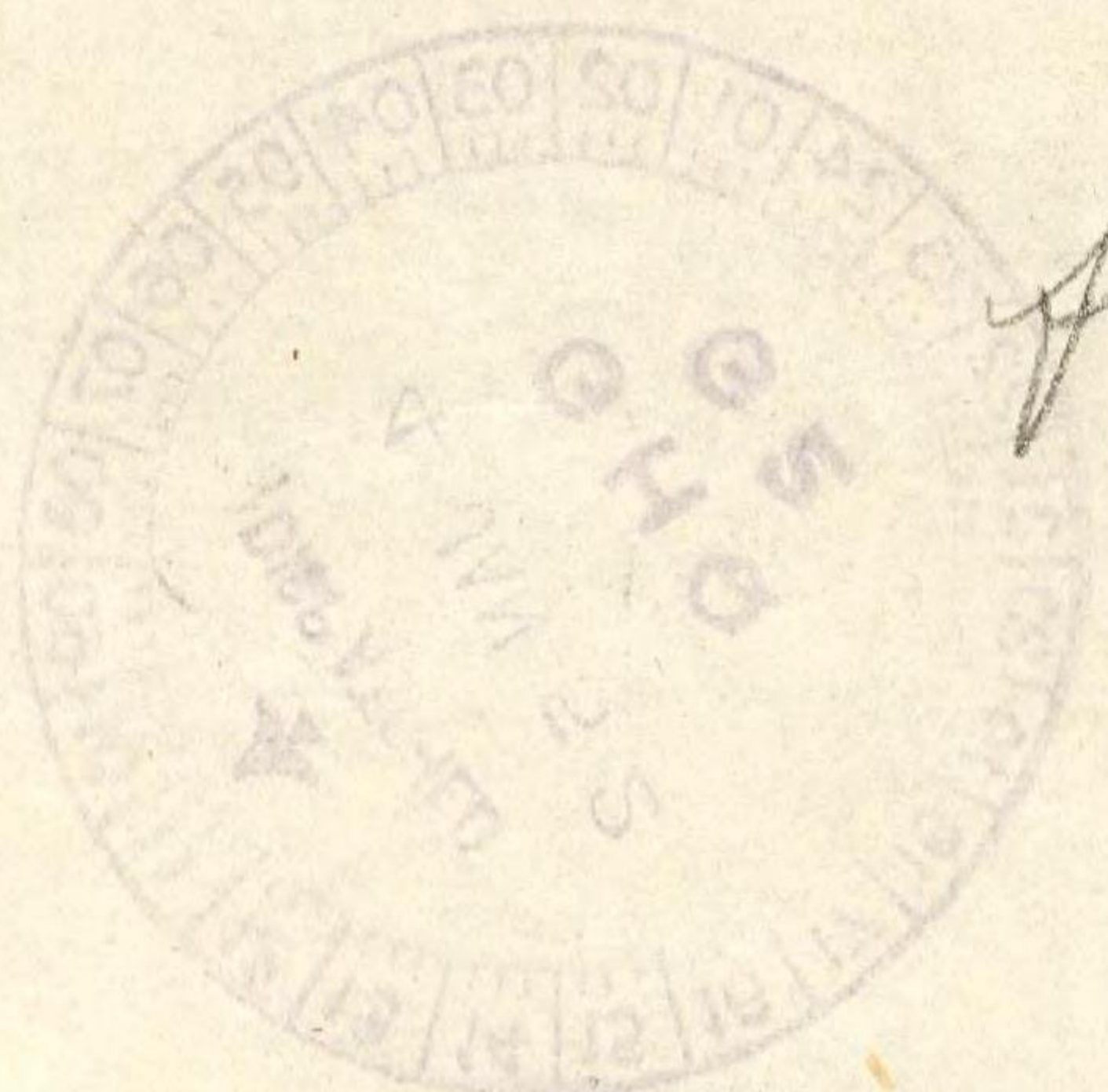

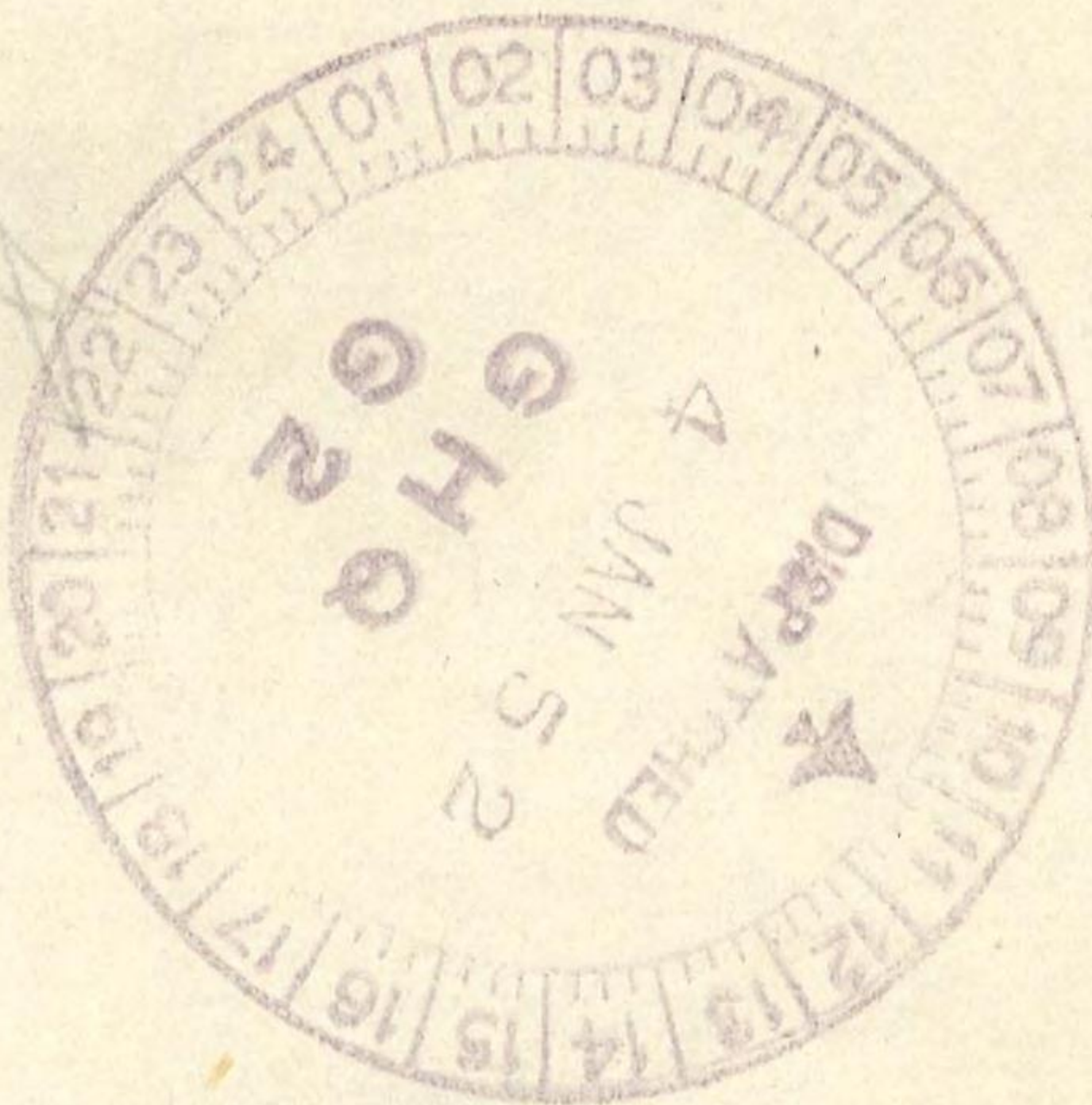
