May 1, 1981.

This report is submitted in fulfillment of the requirements of Section 1014(e) of the Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (Pub. L. 93-344). Section 1014(e) provides for a monthly report listing all budget authority for this fiscal year with respect to which, as of the first day of the month, a special message has been transmitted to the Congress.

This month's report gives the status as of May 1, 1981 of 155 rescissions and 106 deferrals contained in the first nine special messages for fiscal year 1981. These messages were transmitted to the Congress on October 1 and December 2, 1980, January 15 and 29, February 13, March 10, 17, and 19, and April 27, 1981.

Rescissions (Table A and Attachment A)

Rescission proposals totalling \$14,753.9 million are currently pending before the Congress. This includes \$1.5

million transmitted in the fourth special message and released for obligation on March 26, 1981, and \$2,769.5 million transmitted in the eighth special message and released for obligation on April 28. Rescission of these funds is still under active consideration by the Congress. Table A summarizes the status of rescissions proposed by the President as of May 1, 1981, while Attachment A shows the history and status of each rescission proposed during fiscal year 1981.

Deferrals (Table B and Attachment B)

As of May 1, 1981, \$4,740.9 million in 1981 budget authority was being deferred from obligation and another \$10.8 million in 1981 obligations was being deferred from expenditure. Attachment B shows the history and status of each deferral reported during fiscal year 1981.
