THROUGH : Central Liaison Office, Tokyo

SUBJECT : Sale or Transfer of Securities of Certain
Business Firms.

1. It is directed that no sale, trade or other transfer or adjustment of the capital stocks, bonds, debentures, voting trust or other forms of capital securities of the firms listed below, nor of their subsidiary or affiliated firms, shall be made without the prior approval of this Headquarters. For the purposes of this directive a subsidiary or affiliate is defined as any corporation, partnership or stock company in which the firms hereinafter listed hold any stock or other evidences of ownership, indebtedness or control, or directly or indirectly exercise any power of management or direction.

2. It is directed further that such capital securities referred to above shall not be used as collateral for loans, bills, notes or other borrowings or credit, without prior approval of this Headquarters.

MEMORANDUM FOR: THE IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT.

THROUGH : Central Liaison Office, Tokyo.

SUBJECT : Establishment of a Schedule of Restricted Concerns.

1. Reference is made to Memorandum this Headquarters, AG 004 (31 Oct 45)ESS, subject: Sale or Transfer of Securities of Certain Business Firms and to Central Liaison Office Memorandum No. LO 24, dated 29 November 1945 same subject.

2. It will be considered a sufficient compliance with the terms of the reference memorandum of this Headquarters if the action directed therein is applied to the capital stocks, bonds, debentures, voting trusts or other forms of capital securities issued by the holding companies and subsidiaries listed on the inclosure attached hereto. This list hereafter will be referred to as the "Schedule of Restricted Concerns".

3. a. Sales, trades, pledges or other forms of transfers will be exempted from the requirements of the reference memorandum if both of the following exist:

- (1) Neither the beneficial owner nor the record owner of the securities desired to be transferred or otherwise dealt in owns or controls directly or indirectly more than 1% of the outstanding securities of the issue of which his securities are a part.
- (2) The person by whom or on whose behalf the securities are to be acquired does not, and will not by such acquisition, own or control directly or indirectly more than 1% of the securities of the issue proposed to be acquired.

b. In computing the holdings of any person, the combined holdings of his immediate family shall be considered as his holdings.

c. For the purpose of the reference memorandum the following will not be considered as a "sale, trade or other transfer adjustment" and are therefore exempted from its provisions:

SUBJECT : Regulations Affecting Restricted Concerns.

1. Reference is made to Memorandum this Headquarters' AG 004 (8 Dec 45) ESS, subject: Establishment of a Schedule of Restricted Concerns.

2. The Imperial Japanese Government will take immediate action to assure that except as otherwise authorized or directed by this Headquarters each concern listed on the "Schedule of Restricted Concerns" will comply with the following directions:

a. All cash on hand other than that customarily required for payroll and petty cash expenditures will be promptly deposited in the accounts of such concerns with banks in Japan.

b. The proceeds of all sales and loans and all other receipts and income from every source will be promptly deposited upon receipt in the bank accounts of such concerns.

c. No payment, transfer, or withdrawal from any account will be made which is not incidental to the normal course of business of the concern.

d. No sale, transfer, or other disposition of any capital assets including lands, buildings, major items of equipment and securities will be made.

e. No other property will be sold, conveyed, distributed or otherwise disposed of except in the normal course of business and for adequate consideration, and no act will be performed for the purpose of or which has the effect of dissipating assets.

f. No new stock or other participating share interest, however described, will be authorized or issued, and the rights and privileges of any existing stock or other participating share interests will not be reduced or added to or otherwise modified.

g. No bonded indebtedness will be authorized or created and no loans of any other character will be obtained, except in the normal course of business.

- h. No dividends will be paid or declared.
- i. No salary payments in excess of those paid in June, 1945 will be made to the executive officers, including but not limited to, the president, vice-president, secretary, treasurers, directors, managers, advisors and auditors. No bonuses, retirement pay, severance allowances or other emoluments and benefits, except periodic salary payments, will be paid to such executive officers.
3. The Imperial Japanese Government will promptly obtain and furnish to this Headquarters statements from each firm listed on the "Schedule of Restricted Concerns" specifying all payments other than periodic salary payments made on or since 1 July 1945, to any person who on or since such date was an executive officer of such firm and the basis for such payments.
4. Request for approval of any transaction covered by paragraph 2 of this memorandum will be accompanied by the written recommendations of the Minister of Finance, and by such additional data as may be necessary for a thorough understanding of the transaction concerned.
5. The Imperial Japanese Government will acknowledge receipt of this memorandum and promptly report the action taken by it in compliance therewith.

Present stocks will take care of them for two additional months. The only source of this alloy is in the United States and must be imported. They can't get it at present. Would appreciate it if they were given approval to import this item, or get a shipment started on its way. Is there any possible way they ^{can} import this alloy?
4. There is a shortage of skilled workers. Needed quite badly. Mechanist's, etc. Also need carbide quite badly in their electric furnaces. A shortage of rail transportation was also noted. This is quite a common occurrence for most plants!
5. The plant itself is one of the cleanest and most modern plants in the area. They are making high pressure valves at present. Intend to make valves for both water and gas supply. They are operating as much as they can today! The owner employs Henry Ford's system in keeping the plant clean and neat. Strictly on the right side!

TO : Procurement Officer, 37th Mil Gov't Hq & Hq Co. APO 929.

1. This plant is running true to it's application. I am enclosing a list of order received and a list of orders in advance. They have a large order for the Occupation Forces. Namely making valves for family homes in Tokyo and valves for water lines for this housing project.

2. One plant that I have found getting enough coal! However, they are short on coke. They require 200 ton monthly, get 10 ton. Also a shortage of lubricating oils, greases, and gasoline.

3. As explained over the telephone, they use an alloy of cobalt & tungsten for valve seatings. They use approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ ton monthly. Present stocks will take care of them for two additional months. The only source of this alloy is in the United States and must be imported. They can't get it at present. Would appreciate it if they were given approval to import this item, or get a shipment started on its way. Is there any possible way they ^{can} import this alloy?

SUBJECT : Result of Spot Check of Silk Stocks

TO : CO, 95th Hq & Hq Det. Mil Govt Gp.

1. Of the 5 silk factories investigated none had definitely received the SCAP Memorandum to the Japanese government dated 6 Feb 1946, subject: "Restriction on Releases of Silk for Civilian and Military use". They were operating at 50% production on the manufacture of pure silk cloth to be used in making Japanese Obies. This cloth in turn was delivered to the Silk Weaving Control Association, from whom these plants had received their orders and limitations as to what they could manufacture, mainly Obies.

2. The following factories or plants were investigated:

- a. **Kejima Ori Factory**- Not in operation since December, due to the lack of raw material. Specialty is the manufacture of cloth for Obies.
- b. **Matsui Kogyo K.K.**-In operation with about 80% of looms being used, and about 35% in transaction of menies. Specialty is the manufacture of pure silk tablecloths, necktie cloths, and Obies. They had received a directive from the Department of Industry & Commerce limiting them to the manufacture of these articles on a small scale. The product being delivered to the Silk Weaving Control Association.
- c. **Kamei Ori Factory**- A small plant operating at 50% production. Specialty is the manufacture of Obies. The finished product again being sold to and controlled by the Silk Weaving Control Association.
- d. **Abc Ori Factory**- A small plant operating at 45% production. Specialty is the manufacture of Obies and necktie cloths. The finished product again being sold to and controlled by the Silk Weaving Control Association, mentioned above.
- e. **Kawaguchi Ori Factory**- Operating at approximately 25% full production. Finished product is delivered to the same Association.

3. Whether or not the Silk Weaving Control Association has the approval of the Supreme Commander for the manufacture of these goods, has not been determined by this office. From the investigation covered above, it has been deduced that unless approval has been given the association, the memorandum is not being complied with.

1. SCAP Memorandum to the Japanese government dated 6 February 1946, subject: "Restriction on Releases of Silk for Civilian and Military Use", directs that no raw silk, silk thread, silk mixture woven goods, silk finished goods or silk mixture finished garments will be released except upon the specific approval of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers. The Japanese government is directed to enforce the restrictions provided therein and to permit no distribution whatsoever of any silk goods, raw or finished, whether said goods were intended for civilian consumption or military use, without the specific approval of the Supreme Commander.

2. You are directed to conduct immediately a spot check of any ~~five~~ silk mills or warehouses in each prefecture under your jurisdiction to determine (1) whether the provisions of the directive mentioned in paragraph 1 have been made known to the owners thereof, and (2) whether the requirements of the directive are being complied with.

3. You will complete this investigation by 2400 hours, 6 March. The results of the investigation will be transmitted to reach this headquarters not later than 1200 hours, 7 March.
