2. At the recent conference of Region Chiefs, a plan of Kagawa prefecture to make small payments in the form of "tribute" to relatives of Japanese military and civilian personnel who have not been repatriated and whose deaths have been confirmed since 1 April 1950 was discussed.

3. The Kagawa Prefecture plan has been disapproved. Payments with respect to military service would circumvent SCAPIN 338 which prohibits emoluments to ex-military personnel, and payments to relatives of civilians would be contrary to SCAPIN 775 in providing assistance to a special group based on circumstances other than need.
