SUBJECT: Apprehension of Suspected War Criminal

Memorandum to the Imperial Japanese Government dated 7 September 1946, file AG 000.5 (7 Sep 46)LS-R, wherein the Imperial Japanese Government is directed to deliver one MIKI (FNU) Col., to the Commanding General, FICHTH Army at Sugarc Prison (Tokyo Detention Camp), at the earliest practicable date, is amended to delete said MIKI's name for the reason that he is presently incarcerated in SINGAPORE. This name appears as the first name on Page No. 5 of the above-mentioned Memorandum.
