There is no financial gain involved for the individual" - Wikipedia Côte d'Ivoire is a West African country with an unemployment rate close to 20 % (according to the local authorities). Most of countries from sub-Saharan area are familiar with this situation.

In the specific case of the Côte d'Ivoire, among the reasons of this unemployment lie the lack of skill and very often, the inadequacy between the knowledge acquired in the academic programs and the needs of the professional world.

Volunteering is in humble my opinion a remedy to this problem of skill for the volunteer but also for other daily issues faced by our local African communities

In 2009 Avenue 225 started to train for free young people between 18 and 30 years to write for the web.


