REGULATION RELATING TO THE OFFICE ROUTINE OF
THE CENTRAL UNION OF AGRICULTURAL COOPERATIVES
(SANGYO KUMIAI CHUO KAI)

(Revised on Nov. 28, 1932, Sept. 11, '36, Dec. 9,
1937 and Aug. 10, 1937 respectively)

Article 1. - The office routine of the Central Union of Agricultural Cooperatives (hereafter called the Union) shall be executed in accordance with this regulation with the exception of the office routine specified in the constitution of the Union.

Article 2. - The Union shall establish the Executive Section, the enterprise Division, the Home Light Division and the General Affairs Division within its framework.

Article 3. - The Executive Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the formation, revision and abolition of the constitution and regulations of the Union.
2. Matters relating to the meetings of the board of directors, the auditors, the counsellors, and the delegates of the Union.
3. Matters relating to business planning, control of the office routine and coordination business.
4. Matters relating to the Yakuin (Officials assuming the post of director or editor class)
5. Matters relating to the appointment and dismissal

and the reward and punishment of the Shokuin (common officials) and the Yonin (common employee of a lower rank) and other personnel affairs.

6. Matters relating to the official tour of the Yakuin and Shokuin.
7. Matters relating to the safe-keeping of the official seals of the Union, president, vice-president and managing-director.
8. Matters relating to the Union's secrecy.
9. Matters relating to the safe-keeping of the secret documents together with those documents necessitating permanent preservation.
10. Matters relating to commendation.
11. Matters relating to attendance-books and diaries and their arrangement.
12. Matters relating to the coordination with the member organization as well as friendly bodies.

Article 4. - The Enterprise Division shall comprise the planning Section, the Enterprise Section and the Education Section.

The planning Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the planning, control and coordination business concerning "agricultural cooperatives" movement.
2. Matters relating to the enterprise of the branch offices and local chapters.
3. Matters relating to the National Meeting of agricultural cooperatives, the National Conference of Agricultural Cooperatives, the National Conference of the Chairmen of Agricultural Cooperatives and other conferences sponsored by the Union and which do not belong to the business of the other sections.
4. Matters relating to the meeting of agricultural cooperatives, the conference of chairmen of agricultural cooperatives, the consultative conference of agricultural cooperatives, and other~~s~~ conference sponsored by the local chapters in the local districts and which do not fall under the jurisdiction of the other sections.
5. Matters relating to the investigation and planning business.
6. Matters relating to the collection, arrangement, preservation of books and research materials.
7. Matters relating to information business.

8. Matters relating to international agricultural cooperative movement.
9. Matters relating to possible cooperatives to be commended.
10. Matters relating to the business concerning friendly organizations and which does not fall under the jurisdiction of the other sections.
11. Other matters which does not fall under the jurisdiction of the other sections.

The Enterprise Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the guidance, coordination and investigation business concerning enterprises on financing, distribution and joint facilities.
2. Matters relating to the conference, research meeting, etc. to be sponsored by the Union and its local chapters in connection with financing, distribution and joint facilities business.
3. Matters relating to the friendly organizations handling the financing, distribution and joint facilities business.

The Education Section shall handle the following business.

1. Matters relating to the education, public enlightenment and propaganda business.

2. Matters relating to the guidance, coordination and investigation business concerning educational, propaganda and cultural activities.
3. Matters relating to the study meeting and conference concerning short courses and other educational and cultural activities sponsored by the Union and its local chapters.
4. Matters relating to the question and answer business.
5. Matters relating to the publication of the Union's bulletin.

Article 5. - The "Home Light" Division shall comprise the Accountant's Section, the Editorial Section, the Distribution Section and the Propaganda Section.

The Accountant's Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the printing and inspection of magazines.
2. Matters relating to the improvement of magazines.
3. Matters relating to the proceeds.
4. Matters relating to the storage of magazines.
5. Matters relating to advertisement.
6. Matters which do not fall under the jurisdiction of the other sections.

The Editorial Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the compilation of magazines.
2. Matters relating to the collection, arrangement and preservation of the books and research materials required for the compilation of magazines.

The Distribution Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the marketing of magazines.
2. Matters relating to the forwarding of magazines.
3. Matters relating to the statistics and investigations on the marketing and forwarding of magazines.

The Propagation Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the propagation of magazines.
2. Matters relating to the propaganda on magazines.
3. Matters relating to magazine subscribers.

Article 6. - The General Affairs Division shall comprise the General Affairs Section and the Accounts Section.

The General Affairs Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the members of the Union.
2. Matters relating to the business of local chapters.
3. Matters relating to the receipt, forwarding and distribution of documents.

4. Matters relating to the investigation and enforcement of draft documents.
5. Matters relating to the legal procedure on the application, written reports, etc. to the competent ministries together with the preservation of these documents.
6. Matters relating to the arrangement and preservation of important documents such as representations, petitions, etc.
7. Matters relating to the General meeting.
8. Matters relating to writing the business reports.
9. Matters relating to drawing up the estimates for the Union.
10. Matters relating to storage and marketing of publications and miscellaneous articles.
11. Matters relating to the mediation of the transaction of materials.
12. Matters relating to the guidance and supervision of office-boys, mechanics, janitors, cleaning-women and extra-employees.
13. Matters relating to the custody and repairing of office buildings.
14. Matters relating to the guarding, sanitation, cleaning and night duty for the office buildings.
15. Matters relating to the reception of visitors.
16. Matters relating to telephone exchange business.

17. Matters relating to the other business concerning office routine.
18. Matters which do not fall under the jurisdiction of other sections.

The Account's Section shall handle the following business:

1. Matters relating to the collection and counting of membership fee.
2. Matters relating to the custody and disposal of properties.
3. Matters relating to the receipts and disbursements of money and its safekeeping.
4. Matters relating to the payment of expenses.
5. Matters relating to the purchasing, storage and distribution of articles.
6. Matters relating to the settlement of accounts.
7. Matters relating to the account of the Cooperative School attached to the Union.
8. Other matters relating to accountings.

Article 7. - The Executive Section shall have a chief with Shuji rank (secretary rank), and the Executive Division shall also have a chief with Shuji Rank (secretary). The chief of the Executive Section and the chief of the Executive Division respectively shall direct their staff members for the handling of their business under the direction of the president.

Article 8. - Each section shall have its own chief with Shuji rank (secretary rank).

The section chief shall handle the business of the section under the direction of his superior.

Article 9. - In case of the Division chief being unable to handle his business due to personal circumstance the section chief shall act in his place.

In case of the Executive Division chief and the Executive Section chief being unable to execute their business respectively, the superior staff member shall act in their place.

Article 10. - In case of necessity for executing the business each section shall have a branch or branches and appoint a branch chief or branch chieves for the handling of business. The branch chief with shuji rank or assistant shuji rank shall handle the business under the direction of his superior.

Article 11. - Every business shall be executed through the approval of the president.

In case of emergency requiring the prompt enforcement of the program the managing director shall handle the business if unable to get the approval of the president due to certain circumstances, and in case of the absence of the managing director in such an emergency,

Chief and the Executive Section Chief shall act in the place of the managing directors. In this case ex. post facto approval shall be asked from the president.

The president shall be able to have the managing director, the Executive Div. Chief and the Executive Sec. chief act in his place.

Article 12. - Special committee shall be able to be appointed to handle such important business as the National Meeting of Agricultural Cooperatives and other consultative conferences.

Article 13. - The execution of the office routine shall be effected in accordance with the detailed regulations on general affairs and accounting.


