Wikipedia gender bias

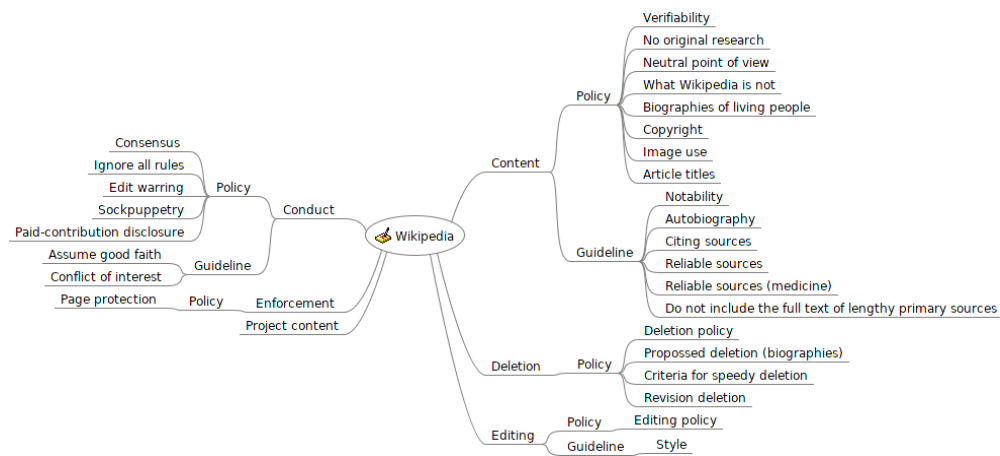
- Failed to fix gender imbalance (2014).

Sinikka Sipilä is a Finnish librarian, was president of the **International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions** - IFLA^[1] 2013–2015, president elect 2011–2013 and member of the governing board 2007–2011 of the Federation and secretary general of the Finnish Library Association^[2] 1997–2015. She studied at the Tampere University the Master in Social Sciences, Library Science and Informatics.

She has been involved in organising their regular Lunar and Planetary Science Conferences since near inception in the 1970s.^[1] She has also been involved with other conferences. She served in the program committee for **Conference on the Origin of the Moon**^[2] and as part her role in the Program Services Department, was involved in the organisation of workshops for the scientific community sponsored by the Lunar and Planetary Institute such as one about differences between antarctic and non-antarctic meteorites held in Austria in 1989^[3] and the Snowbird II conference related to global catastrophes in 1988.^[4]

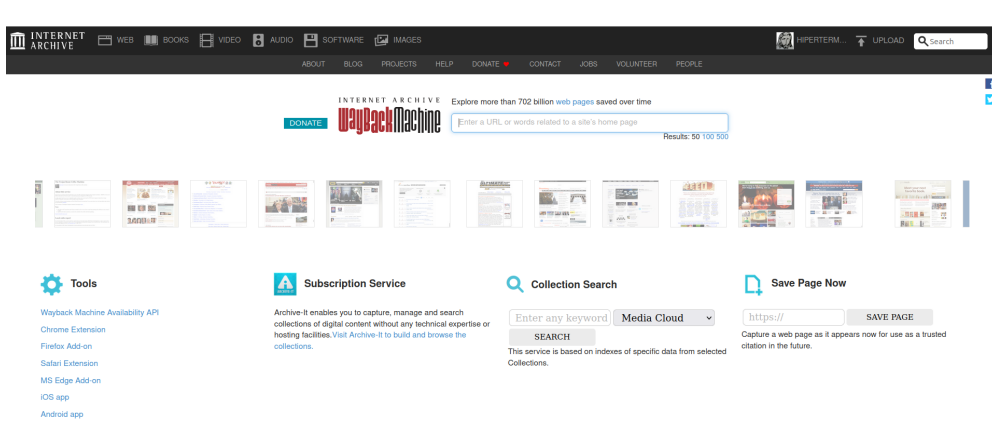

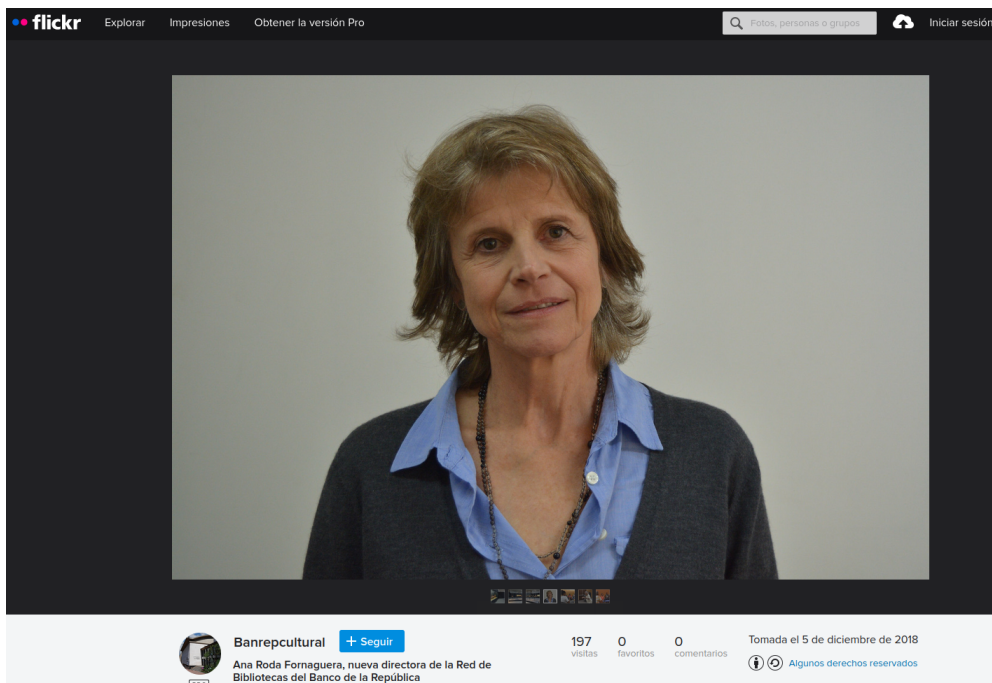
