XII. TACTICAL AND OPERATIONAL DATA.

VD-5 Report No. 34

Lieut. J. T. BROOKS, U.S.N.R., was flight leader for two Squadron PB4Y-LP's for regular coverage of Naha and Chichi Jimas in the Bonins, taking off from Agana Field, Guam, 0630 King, 9 March 1945.

The planes arrived at target at 1134 King and Naha Jima was successfully photographed, without opposition from 20,000 feet; Through practically no cloud cover and Chichi, from the same altitude, through four tenths cumulus. No A.A. fire was seen.

Both planes returned to Guam by 1705 King.
