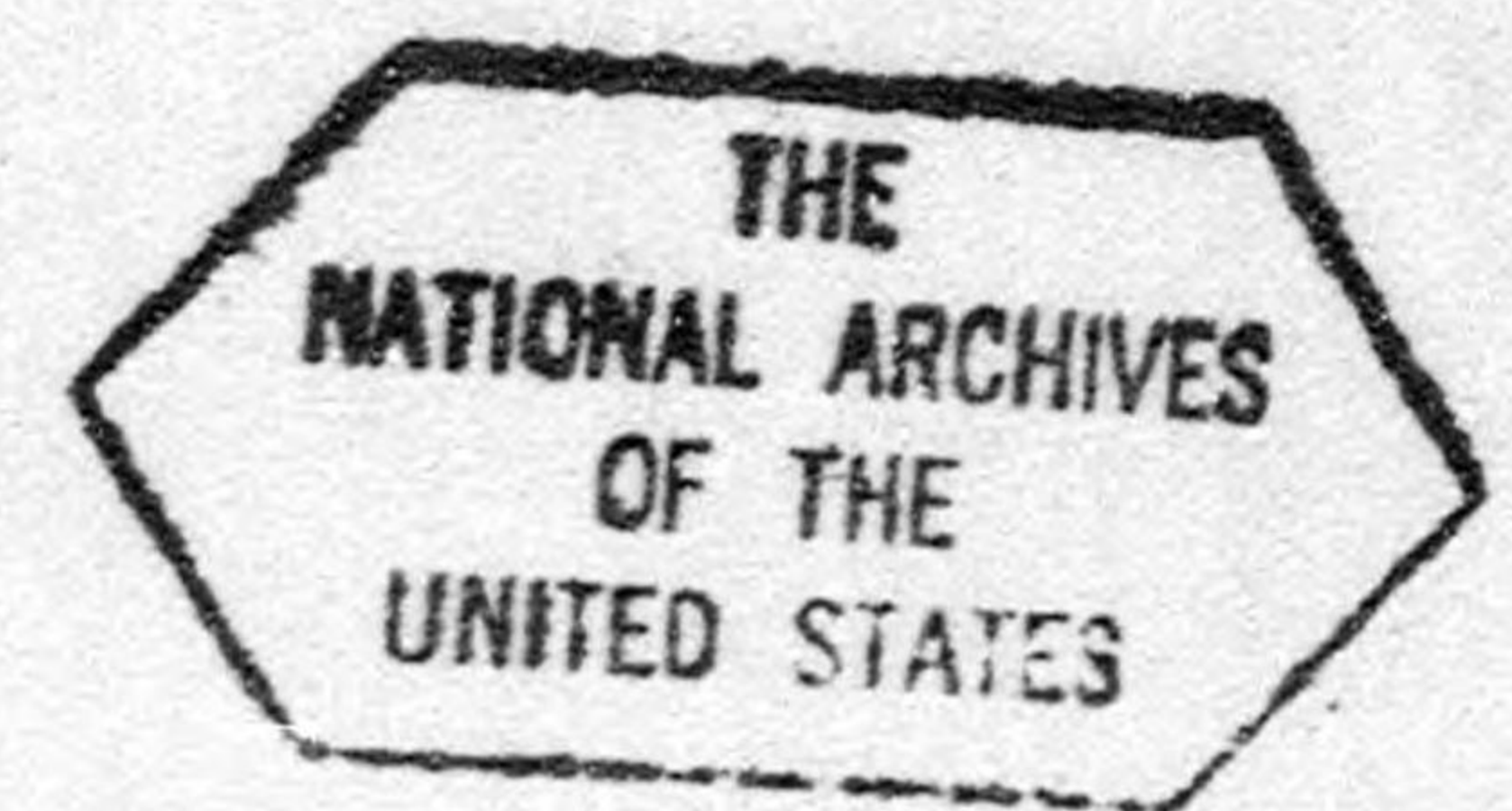

The Constitution

of the International Political and Economic Association
(the Kokusai Seikei Gakukai)

The Kokusai Seikei Gakukai had as its object the study of international secret movements, especially Communism and the Jewish questions, and published the results exclusively to the members of the Association, in periodicals, "Studies of International Secret Powers" (6 volumes, beginning in October, 1936 and ending in April, 1941) and "Studies of Juddism" (beginning in April, 1941).

It also had roundtable conferences from time to time. It was purely a research organization and not open to the public, the membership being about two thousand.

Allotment of Duties

The Chief Director is responsible for every activity of the Association within and without.

The Managing Director is in charge of the research work of the Association and the editing of the periodicals.

The Assistant Managing Director is in charge of daily business as well as the research and editing works.

The Chief Editor is responsible for the actual editing work.

Remarks: In the foregoing list Shichirō Yaginuma was the chief editor of "Studies of International Secret Powers" vol. I—Vol. III and concurrently publisher thereof. After that Itarō Sori became nominally the editor and publisher,

but he had no actual relation to the editing and publishing business.

Beside the above members of staff there were chief of the Branch Offices (in Nagoya, Kyōto, Osaka, Kōbe, Okayama, etc.), but they merely offered services in holding roundtable conferences in their respective places, having no responsibility whatever for the research, editing, and other businesses of the Association.
