















Reminder: You can only share media that you created or was created by your team of volunteers.

You need to be able to release the copyright for the file... or have the original creator share it under an open license on Flickr, YouTube or Similar Platforms








Start with Logging in with your Wikimedia account and clicking on the Upload button


























### File types include....

- Audio (MP3, Ogg, Webm, and others)
- Video (only ogv and webm)
- Other Media (PDF, maps, etc)


# How do we use files on Wikimedia Commons?




#### Default images are ones that you have uploaded, if not what you want search for media files






# Once you select a file click "use this image"






# Write a descriptive caption about the image and click insert
