The Ministry of Home Affairs by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (2) of section six of the Fire Services Act (Northern Ireland) (Reprint), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Qualifications of Chief Officers and of Fire Officers) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948.

(2) In these Regulations the expression “ the principal Regulations ” means the Fire Services (Qualifications of Chief Officers and of Fire Officers) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947.

(3) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations and shall have effect as from the date hereof.

2. The principal Regulations shall have effect as if for the reference to Section Leader in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph (1) of Part II of the Schedule thereto there were substituted a reference to Leading Fireman.

(2) In these Regulations the expression "the principal Regulations" means the Fire Services (Standard Fire Provision) (Western Fire Authority) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947.

(3) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations, and shall have effect as from the date hereof.

ORDER OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND DATED 5TH JANUARY, 1948, UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE ELECTRICITY AND GAS (EXPENSES) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923.

This Order fixes the rate of payment for gas for the year 1948 to the Ministry of Commerce at five pence for each million cubic feet of gas and being of temporary effect is not printed at length in this volume.
