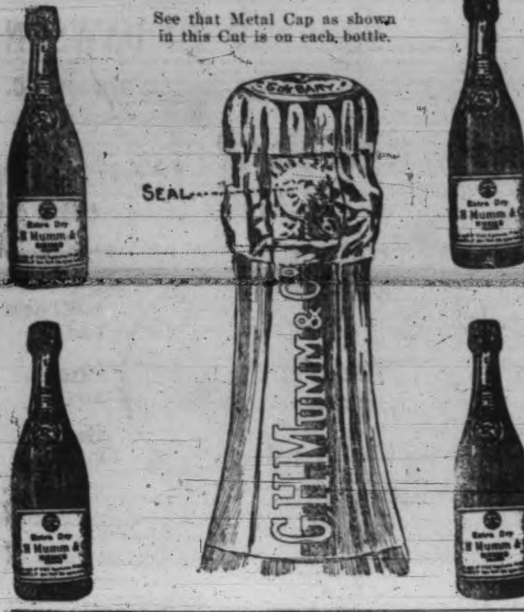

Attention is called to Secs. 22 and 23 of The Waterworks Regulation By-Law, 1888, which read as follows: 'No person shall sprinkle or use in any manner whatsoever water supplied by the city upon lawns, gardens, yards, or grounds of any description, except between the hours of 8 a.m. in the morning and the hours of 5 and 10 o'clock in the evening, unless the water so used shall be supplied by meter.' If water (except water supplied by meter) is used for watering lawns or gardens at other than the permitted hours, there shall be charged against the person so using such water the sum of fifty cents additional for each infraction, but this provision shall in no way prejudice any proceedings for enforcing the penalties attaching to any infraction of this by-law.
