Re Bonnlet 4-21-64.

On 4-30-64, Mr. [Werner Smoydzin, Assistant Chief  
Right-Radicalism Division of the Bundesamt fuer Verfassungs-  
schutz (BfV - West German Federal Agency for the Protection  
of the Constitution),] furnished the following information by  
telephone as an interim report regarding the status of the  
BfV efforts to locate the source of the information in the  
article printed on 11-29-63, in the "Deutsche National-Zeitung  
und Soldaten-Zeitung" (DNZSZ).

Mr. [Smoydzin] said that it had been determined that  
the German student, Dick Kunert, was still in Dallas, Texas.

Mr. [Smoydzin] said that the reporter who had written  
the account of the interview with General Walker had been  
located and interviewed. According to his preliminary  
information, the statement in the article to the effect that  
Oswald had been the one who had shot at Walker was based on  
an assumption made from information obtained from Walker  
during the course of the telephonic interview. Walker had  
not actually said that Oswald had shot at him, but had  
referred to the fact that he had been shot at. The reporter  
reached his own conclusion that Oswald had been responsible  
for this shooting. The second portion of the article which  
refers to the Attorney General's having stopped the investigation  
was added, according to the reporter, by the editors of the  
newspaper.
