A Codification Guide is also published periodically. The Codification Guide is a numerical finding aid to the rules and regulations in the *Federal Register* keyed to the *Code of Federal Regulations*. The Guide is published as follows: Monthly for the months of January, February, April, May, July, August, October, and November, and cumulatively for the periods January–March, January–June, January–September, and January–December (the Annual Codification Guide).
