THE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS AND UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (COLLECTION OF CONTRIBUTIONS FOR PERSONS OVER 65) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1928, DATED MAY 30, 1928, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, ACTING JOINTLY AS RESPECTS CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS, AND BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND AS RESPECTS UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE.

1928. No. 47.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sub-Section 1 of Section 10 of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland by virtue of the powers conferred on it by the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, as amended by the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby make the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Contributory Pensions and Unemployment Insurance (Collection of Contributions for Persons over 65) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1928, and shall be deemed to have had effect as from the 2nd day of January, 1928.
- 2.—(i) Under these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires:—
 - "The Act" means the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925 (15 & 16 Geo. 5, c. 23).
 - "The Ministry" means the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland.

A person "over 65" means a person who is or who under the provisions of the Act must be treated as having attained the age of 65 years, and in respect of whom contributions are payable under the Act.

"The Principal Regulations" means the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1924 to 1927, or the Unemployment Insurance (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, 1920, as amended by the

Unemployment Insurance (Collection of contributions) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1926, or both as appropriate to the particular case.

- (ii) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3.—(i) The provisions of the Principal Regulations (other than those which relate to arrears cards, payment of arrears, record card and benefit records) shall with the necessary modifications apply to a person over 65 as if he were an insured contributor or an employed contributor who had not attained that age.
- (ii) The Unemployment Insurance (Exempt Persons) Regulations, 1920, shall not apply in the case of a person over 65.
- 4. In the case of a person over 65 every contribution payable under the provisions of the Act or of the Unemployment Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), 1920 to 1928, as amended by the Act, shall be paid by the affixing of a stamp to a card, and the expression "Unemployment Book" or "Book" in the Principal Regulations shall include such a card.
 - 5.—(i) The cards shall in all cases be issued by the Ministry.
- (ii) All cards in respect of persons over 65 shall be in the forms set out in the Schedule to these Regulations or in such forms substantially to the like effect as may from time to time be approved by the Ministry and shall be supplied without charge.

(iii) All directions and instructions appearing upon the cards supplied in accordance with this Article shall be deemed to be

incorporated in these Regulations.

- 6.—(i) If a person over 65 does not receive a card before the time when it is required for presentation to his employer he shall apply to a Local Office of the Ministry for the issue to him of a card.
- (ii) Where a person over 65 fails to deliver up to his employer a card for the purpose of being stamped the employer, instead of paying any contributions on an emergency card or on an emergency book, shall apply to a Local Office of the Ministry for the issue to him of a card, and shall forthwith inscribe thereon the name and address of the person over 65 for whom it is required, and shall comply with the provisions of the Principal Regulations as if the card had been delivered up to him by the person over 65.
- (iii) The cards shall in all cases be surrendered to the Ministry, and accordingly the provisions of the principal Regulations as regards the surrender of cards by employed contributors to Approved Societies shall apply where appropriate with the substitution of the Ministry for the Approved Societies.

- 7. Where an employer has in his possession or under his control any Unemployment Book or Card issued under the Principal Regulations in respect of a person over 65, he shall, as soon as may be, return it duly stamped to that person, and that person shall forthwith surrender the Unemployment Book to the Ministry and the card to his Society, or if he is not a member of a Society, to the Ministry.
- 8. A person over 65 shall not be entitled to pay any contributions under sub-section (4) of Section 7 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1924, and accordingly shall not affix any stamps to his card in respect of any period of unemployment.

- (3) When 52 contributions have been paid in the current contribution year in respect of an Outworker to whom this card applies, no further contributions will then be payable in respect of the Outworker during that period.
- (4) The Outworker on receiving this Card from the Employer must sign his name in the space provided overleaf. He must send it with his Class P (A) Card (if he has one) to the Ministry of Labour, at the address below, at the end of the half-year. If he has not received a Class P (A) Card he must give the other information required in the space overleaf and send this card immediately to:—

Any person finding a lost card should drop it into a Post Office letter-box. If this Card is otherwise sent through the post it must be put into an envelope and postage must be prepaid unless the Card is sent to the Ministry of Labour.
