The letter was sent by an unknown writer from Paris, France in early December 1964 to William B. Snidow, United States Department of State employee to an address in Beirut, Lebanon. The letter was forwarded by sea pouch to Snidow in Barranquilla. Since the letter was of no personal interest to Snidow, he turned it over to Gerald R. Roberger for such action as he deemed appropriate.

2. The letter apparently indicates that the writer wants to contact the Central Intelligence Agency and in one paragraph suggests that the reader not forget Barnon Michell and William Miller.

TRANSLATION

I want to write to you about a very interesting matter. First, I shall send a code to you. All of my letters will be in code. You are to give the letters to (CIA) [because it is not your service]. I shall come to see you, the first chance I get.

I am obliged to keep secret the name of the country where I am presently located; the reason - Vernon Mitchell and William Martin, do not forget.

Give me a private address (postal box). In order that you may show that you have received my letter, do the following (25-26-27...12-1964) place advertisements (The Daily Star) (a) Lebanese newspaper, three days (in a row), car for sale, must sell quickly because going on trip.

Pedoto (Peugeot) 2651 kms.

Please give me a post box address.

UB: appears letter written by a less than average educated Spanish speaker.
