### Why goat is a great symbol



- The goat population in the world is growing
- Goats can survive in the most marginal regions of the world, and people can survive because of goats
- Female goats have beards too and no one questions that
- Goats are agile: They can do amazing things, e.g. climb on trees
- Goats are smart
- Goats need other goats to be happy
- -> Importance for the world and the people, diversity, collective culture, agile approaches








### Diversity: Anyone can join, many have already joined. No common demographic.











### Goatification worked for ...

- People from all over the world
- Staff and volunteers alike
- People who have hardly ever used Phabricator before: Goatification made them enter a technical space
- Developers, content contributors
- People who weren't at Wikimania ...





## Network as default: No leader, no gatekeeper, and no permissions

- Network as the default model
- No leader helps avoid bottlenecks
- No one telling you what to do, how to do it -> space to innovate, space to grow, space to take your own responsibility

Movement Strategy:

Building the ecosystem aka network of Open Knowledge ...!



# Fun-driven, collaborative culture





- Laughter is contagious
- Lots of energy is contagious
- Cryptic messages make you want to know what is happening
- Appreciation tokens, swag and secret greetings increase excitement
- Celebration of all contributions is a pleasure, and it makes you feel valued, and part of the fun

### Inclusiveness across platforms

People who weren't at Wikimania reacted differently:

- Some people who were not there started to tweet goaty things and to contribute goat ideas
- Other people verbalized feeling excluded -> We had to explain the history of #goatification on Phabricator
- We managed to be quite inclusive at the event, but not entirely beyond

! Make sure you transfer your idea across platforms or events. Find ways of including all people who might be interested.

# Goatification worked better than any social event:


#### New/old contacts:
