
15 October: Philippines - Earthquake (as of 07:00 UTC)





SITUATION

- On 15 October at 00:12 UTC an earthquake of Magnitude 7.1M at a depth of 20 km hit Bohol island (Central Visayas). (GDACS)
 USGS-PAGER indicates shaking
- island (Central Visayas). (GDACS)
 USGS-PAGER indicates shaking
 of up to "Severe" for 185 000
 people. No significant tsunami
 risk was posed by this
 earthquake, JRC calculations
 indicate a max. height of around
 0.3m in Guindulman.
- As of 07 UTC 15 Oct NDRRMC:

28 dead (Cebu: 9, Bohol:18, Siquijor:1)

159 injured

Public **buildings collapsed** (Port and airport terminals, Municipal buildings in Bohol, Cebu)

 News agencies report 49 people killed. Assessment still ongoing.

Recent severe weather in the Philippines

- In the past weeks several areas of Philippines have been affected by heavy rains, floods and Tropical Cyclones (see map)
 - In **Luzon**, due to the **passage of NARI** (locally called SANTI) on 11-12 October, there were (as of late 14 October, UTC, NDRRMC): 15 dead, 53 040 houses damaged, 71 628 people
 - displaced.
 Last week heavy rains and thunderstorms affected also parts of Visayas and Mindanao (striped blue areas in the inset map). As of 13 October, 123 000 people were displaced.
